



Who is affected?

The regulation applies to:

-COMMERCIAL AIR TRANSPORT AEROPLANE OPERATIONS (SCHEDULE AND CHARTER)

The following operations are currently exempt:

- ➤ Air taxi as defined by Reg.83/2014;
- ➤ Emergency Medical Services (EMS-airplanes)
- ➤ Single pilot;
- ➤ Helicopter.....for now

FLIGHT DUTY PERIOD (ORO.FTL.205 + CS FTL 1.205)

Max FDP

13h (as OPS 1-2 sectors/06-13:29 only)

- Start of FDP (REPORTING TIME)

- N. of Sectors (1-10)

MAXIMUM (BASIC) DAILY FDP - ADVANTAGES

- -(b) Detailed table, instead of calculation, to avoid misinterpretation;
- -(b) Window of FDP max. 11h is now extended between 17:00 & 04:59

- **Night Duty: Max 4 sectors for consecutive Night Duty**
 - FRM required if Night Duties > 10hs

MAX DAILY FDP WITH THE USE OF EXTENSIONS WITHOUT IN-FLIGHT REST (ORO.FTL.205(d))

- Same EU-OPS: max 1 h, max twice every 7 cons. days;
 - mitigations (pre/post flight rest +2h or post +4h);
 - max 5 legs limitations;

-Shall be planned in advance (d)(3);

MAX DAILY FDP WITH THE USE OF EXTENSIONS DUE TO IN-FLIGHT REST (ORO.FTL.205(e))

Art.4 Regolamento integrativo ENAC:

- +3h /+5h on PSV
- adeguate seats
- Uninterrupted rest

- >Sectors (max 3)
- **▶**Rest 90min/2 h for FCM landing
- ➤ Rest facilities (Class 1/2/3 No economy class)
- > Augmentation of Flight Crew

For FCMs, FDP may be increased of 1 more h. (1 sector >9h / max 2)

MAX DAILY FDP WITH THE USE OF EXTENSIONS DUE TO IN-FLIGHT REST

Actual Max PSV is 13h + 5h= 18 h

PILOTS: 4 FCM + class 1 rest facility+ 1h extention = 18h

CABIN CREW: max rest time (3:50) + class 1 rest facility = 18h

ENAC INTENDS TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE OPT-OUT TO PERMIT RECONFIGURATION

UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES— COMM. DISCRETION ORO.FTL.205(F)

- ➤ Max FDP EXTENTION: unchanged(2h/3h augmented Crew)
- > Reports to CAA: unchanged
- Delayed reporting as for CS FTL.1.205 → NEW FDP if CM is informed of delayed reporting (+/- 4h 10h)

EVERYTHING AFTER REP. TIME IS UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

Operator SHALL implement a NON PUNITIVE process on O. M. Operator SHALL estabilish procedure on dalayed rep. on O. M.

CUMULATIVE FLIGHT TIMES AND D.P. (ORO.FTL .210);

Cumulative Flight Time & Duty Periods unchanged

NEW "ROLLING LIMITS"

- Max Duty hours in any 14 consec. days: 110h
 Max Flight time in any 12 consec. months: 1000h

N.B.: Post flight counts as Duty Period. Operator shall specify on **OPERATION MANUAL time for post-flight duties.**

REST PERIODS (ORO.FTL.235 + CS FTL 1.235);

Minimum Rest at home base/away h.b: Unchanged

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Min.Rest away home base: 8hs sleeep (unchanged)+
(10h)
- traveling time &
- phisiological needs (1h)

Min rest away home base = 8hs + 1h+ travelling time

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REST PERIOD – (ORO.FTL.235)

RECURRENT EXTENDED RECOVERY REST PERIODS

Recurrent extended recovery rest periods planned

- 36 hours, including 2 local nights,
- one RERRP every 168 hours (7 days)

RERRP

168h (7 days)

RERRP

The RERRP shall be increased to 2 local days twice every month.

REST PERIOD – ADDITIONAL REST PERIODS

(ORO.FTL.235(e))

- > Time zone differences
- >Additional fatigue due to disruptive schedules;

Change of home base.



REST PERIOD - ADDITIONAL REST PERIODS

(CS FTL.1.235)

- Time zone differences: 4 h time difference or more
 - east-west & v.v. rotations
- Disruptive schedules : transition late/night to early
 - 4 night Duty or more b/teen 2RERRP

REST PERIOD -REDUCED REST (CS FTL.1.235)

REDUCED REST IS USED UNDER FATIGUE RISK MANAGMENT
