1 Full description of the AltMoC, which includes reasoning of the AltMoC

There are several instances when personnel employed by the Competent Authority (specifically the Flight Inspectors), or by an ATO approved by the Competent Authority, is routinely used in the capacity of teachers/instructors for the standardization courses relevant to the issue/revalidation/renewal of examiner certificates. Such personnel may often be the only one available with an adequate experience and knowledge to hold such courses. In order to allow the revalidation/renewal of the examiners certificate of this personnel without undue delay (which may cause a disruption to the “standardization courses” and “refresher seminars”), it has been deemed of help the possibility of granting credit for this personnel in respect to the participation to a “refresher seminars” as required by the FCL.1025

A person who is employed by the Competent Authority or by an ATO to teach for course(s) and seminar(s) as prescribed by the requirements in FCL.1025(b)(2) of the Reg. E.U. 1178/2011 can have full credit towards the requirement of FCL.1025(b)(2) only for the revalidation or renewal of his/her certificate(s). Circumstances in which the full credit may be applied are those where the teacher/instructor has participated to the full “standardization course” providing full or part of the course

2 Assessment demonstrating that the IR(s) are met

This AltMoC is aimed to the revalidation and renewal of examiner certificate(s) for personnel employed as Instructor(s)/Teacher(s) for the “examiner standardization course” or “examiner refresher seminar” provided by the Competent Authority, or by an ATO approved and acting under the management system of the Competent Authority. The AMC1 FCL.1025 requires that the “examiner refresher seminar” should follow the content of the “examiner standardization” course as included in AMC1 FCL.1015 and taking into account specific contents adequate to the category of examiner affected. The paragraphs that follow show a full compliance with the requisites expressed in the FCL.1025(b) and its AMCs



3 *Procedures for the use of the AltMoC*

AltMoC Procedure for the ATO

Pre-requisites

The applicant shall:

- a) be holder of an examiner certificate
- b) have all other prerequisites for the relevant “examiner certificate” as expressed in the Reg EU 1178/2011 satisfied
- c) be part of the personnel reported in the relevant Operation manual of the ATO as teacher/instructor for the “standardization course” or “refresher seminar

Requisites

The applicant shall:

- a) have an assessment of competence as per FCL.1020
- b) Have completed at least 2 “standardization course” or “refresher seminar” every year during the period of validity of the examiner certificate
- c) have completed the last “standardization course” or “refresher seminar” within 6 months preceding the revalidation/renewal of his/her examiner certificate
- d) have at least one “refresher seminar” or “standardization course” supervised by an Inspector from the Competent Authority
- e) have the point (1), (3) and subparagraphs (c) and (d) of the FCL.1025 fully satisfied
