Being aware that pursuant to articles 75 and 76 of the Italian Law 445/2000 in case of false declarations ascertained by ENAC, the penalties envisaged will be applied, signing the present application I, on behalf of the operator, DECLARE that: 1) Copy of documents listed in section 4 related to the aircraft listed in section 3 are valid 2) Flight are conducted by pilots holding the appropriate licenses and type rating issued in accordance with the ICAO standards 3) Aircraft will be operated in accordance with the limitations/conditions established in the Manuals and further limitations attached to the Airworthiness Certificate 4) Aircraft has the required equipment installed in order to operate in the aerial spaces for which the authorization is requested 5) Manufacture's maintenance program is satisfied, except waives expressly granted by the Authority of the State of registry or by a maintenance organization recognized by ENAC 6) Flight are conducted in compliance with the Italian rules of the air and the procedures published in the national aeronautical publication (AIP and NOTAM) 7) Remunerated flight activity is not allowed unless authorized by ENAC 8) Certificate of Insurance listed in section 4 complies with Regulation (EC) 785/2004 9) No Weapons, Munitions and/or Dangerous Goods are carried on board of the aircraft listed in section 3 7.
