**Subject: Notification on revocation of Part-145 approval certificate and suspected terminated operation of design organisation**

**Maintenance issues –**

National Transport Authority, Aviation Authority (NTA AA) of Hungary hereby would like to inform EASA Flight Standards Directorate and Certification Directorate and the other EASA Member States about the status of Notheisz Balloons Hungary Ltd.

Maintenance organisation approval of Notheisz Balloons Hungary Ltd. (HU.145.0100) was suspended by NTA AA on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2015, due to level 1 findings (and some level 2 findings) raised on a continuation inspection. Such kind of findings were: *lack of certifying staff AML licence, lack of used documentation data on CRS, incorrect approval and licence number on CRS, quality manager without approved EASA Form 4 and relevant knowledge, lack of approved MOE at the facility.*


The company failed to demonstrate any corrective actions in timescale granted by NTA AA, therefore HU.145.0100 approval was revoked fully by NTA AA on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2016. The company had not appealed against the revocation in timescale granted by NTA AA i.a.w. Hungarian national rules.

**Design issues –**

Due to unable to contact with the company by regular post, nor via email or phone, it is suspected that the activity of alternative design organisation section of the company had also been terminated.

Therefore NTA AA would like to ask EASA Certification Directorate to inspect whether the company is able to manage its ADOA approval (EASA.AP.322) and to maintain the design of TOMI hot air balloons (TCDS EASA.BA.025).
