Action required: To implement, as necessary, Assembly Resolutions A36-26, A31-29 and A32-3 by ratifying the instruments mentioned therein

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to refer to the semi-annual ICAO State letters regarding notification of acts of signature, ratification or accession to international air law instruments, for which the Organization is the depositary. I am pleased to advise that the information contained in these State letters has been transferred to the expanded Treaty Collection on the ICAO website at www.icao.int, with revised presentation.

Consequently, the regular semi-annual State letters on ratification matters will be discontinued and States are encouraged to actively use the online ICAO Treaty Collection which comprises the following materials:

- Current lists of parties to air law treaties (The lists of parties to those air law treaties for which ICAO is the depositary, previously contained in Attachment A to the semi-annual State letters, are promptly updated and made available on the website.)
- Status of individual States with regard to multilateral air law treaties
- Composite table showing the status of treaties and status of individual States vis-à-vis treaties
- Chronological record of depositary activity
- Administrative packages to assist States in becoming parties to treaties
- 6. Assembly Resolutions related to ratification matters (previously contained in Attachment B to the semi-annual State letters)
- Current information and recommendations concerning ratification matters
