In accordance with EASA SIB No 2014-32R1, the HCAA FSD, as the Aircraft Maintenance Licensing Authority of Greece, informs all individuals, who hold a HCAA Part-66 Aircraft Maintenance Licence (AML) based on Certificates of Recognition (CoR) issued for Technical Modules (7, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & 17) by former MTO HATA [EL.147.0007], and work outside the Greek territory, as well as all approved organisations they work for, be they CAMOs or AMOs, that said licence holders should be assessed for their knowledge on the above Technical Modules, according to one of the following procedures:

1- Submit an application to the HCAA FSD (Fax:+30 210 9973060, e-mail: d2@hcaa.gr, d2a@hcaa.gr, d2aw@hcaa.gr) no later than 15-Feb-2017, in order to participate in an evaluation of their level of knowledge in the above mentioned Technical Modules, that is to be held in Athens Greece, at the HCAA facilities during 6 to 10 of March 2017, or

2- Submit an application to the Competent Authority responsible for the oversight of the above mentioned approved organisations, as described in the SIB No 2014-32R1 item 2(b), page 3 of 6.

The results (of the evaluation) must be submitted to the HCAA FSD (Fax:+30 210 9973060, e-mail: d2@hcaa.gr, d2a@hcaa.gr, d2aw@hcaa.gr) not later than 10-Mar-2017.

Meanwhile, until their level of knowledge is evaluated, the privileges of their AMLs are suspended.
