Virus "EBOLA" procedures for contract tracing of passengers coming from affected countries by air.

In line with the international recommendations concerning issues of international public health (IAA, OMS, ICAO ...) and in accordance with the instructions by the Ministry of the Health, it is considered mandatory for all companies performing direct and indirect flights to/from countries affected by the epidemic or reporting sporadic cases, retain the passenger lists for at least 21 days (the maximum incubation EVD). The lists shall be made immediately available to the Authority for Health (USMAF/central offices of the Ministry of Health) in the event it is required to activate contract tracing procedures for suspected cases reported by the Captain of an arrival flight or by the structures the National Health Service in the days following the date of the flight.

In order to facilitate the operations on the airports it is required that the Air Carrier has on board a number 'passenger locator cards' proper to passengers on board and the crew.
