

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

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Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.












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Key data - April 2024

Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to April 2024 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.


Traffic data related to **passengers** show as during **April 2024** about **18,4 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+11,8%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+14,0%** compared to April 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **April 2024** air traffic reached about **101,3 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+22,9%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+17,5%** compared to April 2019.




Passengers - April 2024 National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In April the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 6.040.218 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and an increase of +4,2% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **2.845.671 units**, accounting for the **47%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+8,0%** compared to April. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 841.681 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.



International Scope - Share by geographical area

In April the **international passengers** traffic recorded **12.407.996 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+15,9%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (6.040.218 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.






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International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area


Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: +71,9%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,0%, meaning +108.892 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +9,7%, meaning +1.038.430 passengers.





Low-cost Carriers


In April the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 11.925.547 units, corresponding to **65%** out of the total and an increase of **+7,2%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **6.268.063 units**, accounting for the **53%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,2% compared to April. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 1.696.786 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.





Legacy Carriers

In April the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 6.522.667 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of **+21,4%** compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.806.975 units**, accounting for the **74%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +21,4% compared to April 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 2.399.663 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

Cargo - April 2024 National Scope - Top-5 Airports


In April the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 5.956 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of total and a decrease of -8,8% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.951 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-12,8%** compared to April 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 31%, which matches to 1.860 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In April the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **95.369 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+25,7%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (5.956 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.






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Cargo - April 2024

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International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Africa & Indian Ocean**: **+75,9%** area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,9%, meaning **+672** tons. In **relative** terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: **+11,5%**, meaning **+8.737** tons.









Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.











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Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - April have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to **passengers** show as during the period **January - April** about **58,5 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+12,0%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+9,1%** compared to the period January - April 2019.


As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - April** air traffic reached about **383,4 K tons**, recording an **increase** of **+18,6%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+15,7%** compared to January - April 2019.



Passengers – January - April 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - April, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 19.738.163 units, corresponding to **34%** out of the total and an increase of +4,2% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **9.770.840 units**, accounting for the **50%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+10,2%** compared to January - April 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 15%, witch matches to 2.988.496 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.






Passengers – January - April 2024

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - January - April the **international passengers** traffic recorded **38.803.460 units**, corresponding to **66%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+16,4%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (19.738.163 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas the main route.








Passengers – January - April 2024

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific:** +118,5% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,6%, meaning +524.924 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +9,4%, meaning +3.121.641 passengers.





Passengers – January - April 2024 Low-cost Carriers

During the period January - April the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 36.563.118 units, corresponding to **62%** out of the total and an increase of **+5,6%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 4 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **20.230.676 units**, accounting for the **55%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,6% compared to January - April 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 5.265.288 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.



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Passengers – January - April 2024 Legacy Carriers

During the period January - April the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 21.978.505 units, corresponding to **38%** out of the total and an increase of **+24,4%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 4 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **16.612.252 units**, accounting for the **76%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +24,9% compared to January - April 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 8.177.189 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.








Cargo – January - April 2024 National Scope - Top-5 Airports


During the period January - April, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 24.744 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -19,7% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **16.337 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-23,6%** compared to January - April 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 30%, witch matches to 7.524 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - April the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **358.612 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+22,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (24.744 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.






Cargo – January - April 2024

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: **+94,0%** area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +13,8%, meaning **+40.387** tons. Also in **relative** terms, **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: **+13,8%**.
