







Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.











Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to May 2024 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during **May 2024** about **20,1 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+13,0%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+17,8%** compared to May 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **May 2024** air traffic reached about **109,1 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+17,6%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+16,8%** compared to May 2019.



Passengers - May 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In May the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 6.573.277 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and an increase of +6,3% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.097.449** units, accounting for the 47% out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,4% compared to May. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 915.892 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.



International Scope - Share by geographical area

In May the **international passengers** traffic recorded **13.533.269 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+16,6%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (6.573.277 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.






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Passengers - May 2024

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: +57,5%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,8%, meaning +92.782 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +10,7%, meaning +1.241.823 passengers.






Low-cost Carriers

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In May the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 12.905.047 units, corresponding to **64%** out of the total and an increase of **+9,6%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 2 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **6.684.917 units**, accounting for the **52%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +13,2% compared to May. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 1.777.523 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.



Passengers - May 2024

Legacy Carriers

In May the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 7.201.499 units, corresponding to **36%** out of the total and an increase of +19,8% compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 2 percentage points. Top five airports reached a traffic of **5.197.034 units**, accounting for the **72%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +18,5% compared to May 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 2.638.359 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

Cargo - May 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In May the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 7.135 tons, corresponding to **7%** out of total and a decrease of -12,0% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.586 tons**, accounting for the **64%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-17,7%** compared to May 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 29%, which matches to 2.096 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.





International Scope - Share by geographical area

In May the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **101.930 tons**, corresponding to **93%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+20,5%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.135 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **United States of America** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.






Cargo - May 2024

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +56,6% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,1%, meaning +942 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +9,8%, meaning +8.269 tons.









Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.












Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - May have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period **January - May** about **78,6 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+12,2%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+11,2%** compared to the period January - May 2019.


As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - May** air traffic reached about **492,4 K tons**, recording an **increase** of **+18,4%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+15,9%** compared to January - May 2019.



Passengers – January - May 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - May, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 26.311.440 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and an increase of +4,7% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **12.868.289 units**, accounting for the **49%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+10,3%** compared to January - May 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 15%, witch matches to 3.904.388 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.



International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - January - May the **international passengers** traffic recorded **52.336.727 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+16,5%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (26.311.440 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas the main route.



International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area


Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +200,0% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,0%, meaning +12 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +9,7%, meaning +4.363.464 passengers.





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During the period January - May the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 49.468.165 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of +6,6% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 3 percentage points. **Top five** airports reached a traffic of 26.915.593 units, accounting for the 54% out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,3% compared to January - May 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 7.042.811 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.



Passengers – January - May 2024

Legacy Carriers

During the period January - May the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 29.180.002 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of **+23,2%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **21.775.309 units**, accounting for the **75%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +23,2% compared to January - May 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 10.815.548 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.





Cargo – January - May 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - May, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 31.879 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -18,1% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **20.884 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-22,6%** compared to January - May 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 30%, witch matches to 9.620 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.






Cargo – January - May 2024

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - May the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **460.543 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+22,1%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (31.879 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.






Cargo – January - May 2024

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +84,3% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +12,9%, meaning +48.656 tons. Also in <u>relative</u> terms, **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +12,9%.
