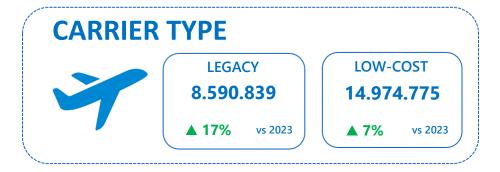


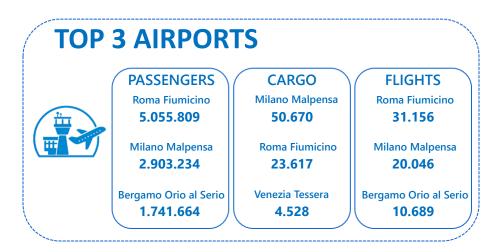

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.



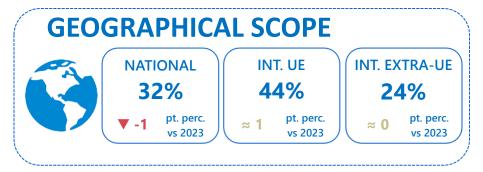




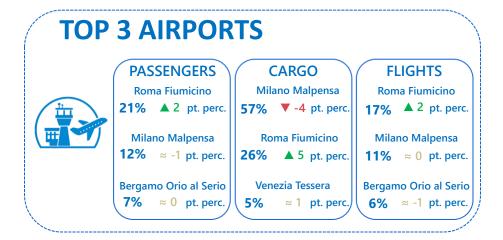

#### Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to August 2024 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during **August 2024** about **23,6 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+10,7%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+15,2%** compared to August 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **August 2024** air traffic reached about **89,5 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+14,9%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+22,2%** compared to August 2019.



## Passengers - August 2024

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In August the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 7.448.905 units, corresponding to **32%** out of the total and an increase of +7,0% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.234.473** units, accounting for the 43% out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,8% compared to August. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 1.021.727 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.

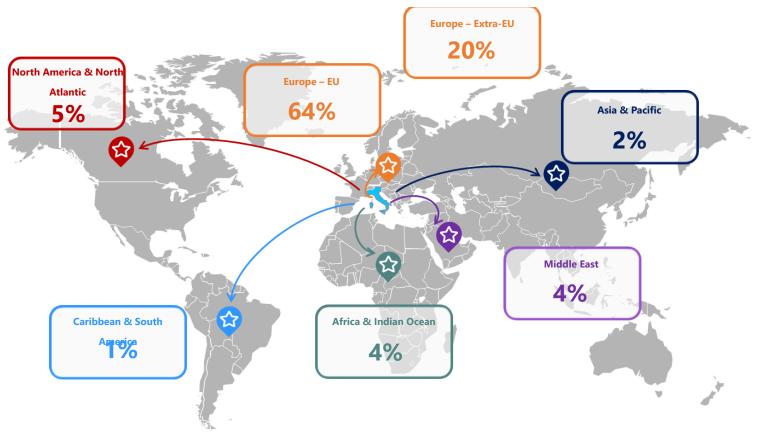

#### Passengers - August 2024

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

In August the **international passengers** traffic recorded **16.116.709 units**, corresponding to **68%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+12,4%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.448.905 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.

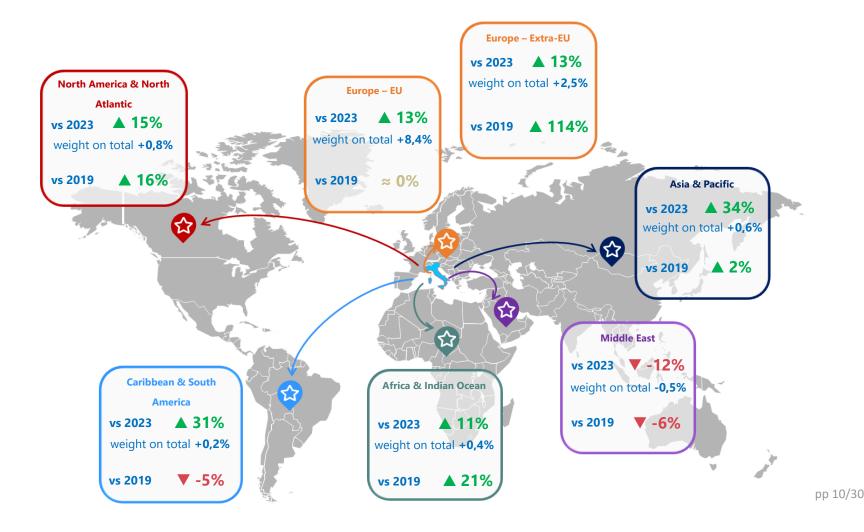




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#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: +111,1%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,0%, meaning +10 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +8,4%, meaning +1.209.541 passengers.





#### **Low-cost Carriers**

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In August the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 14.974.775 units, corresponding to **64%** out of the total and an increase of +7,2% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 2 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **7.467.978 units**, accounting for the **50%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,9% compared to August. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 13%, which matches to 1.962.109 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

## Legacy Carriers

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In August the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 8.590.839 units, corresponding to **36%** out of the total and an increase of **+17,3%** compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 2 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **5.970.002 units**, accounting for the **69%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +17,1% compared to August 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 36%, which matches to 3.093.700 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - New York John F Kennedy Intl represent the main route.

## Cargo - August 2024

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In August the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 5.510 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of total and steady values, with a variation of -0,8% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.657 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-2,2%** compared to August 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 26%, which matches to 1.433 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.

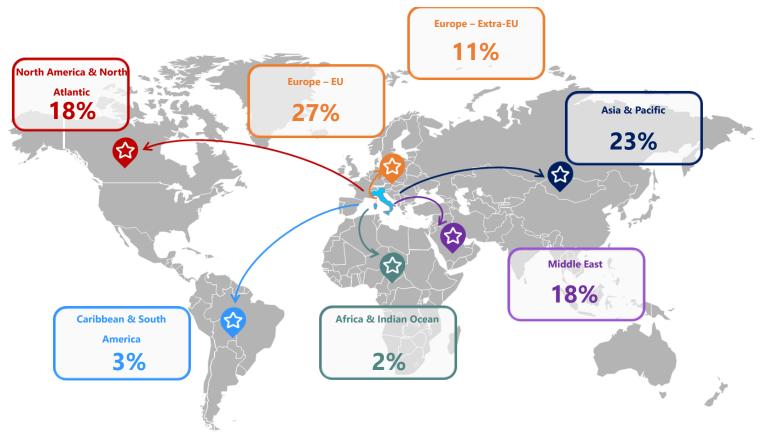


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## Cargo - August 2024

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

In August the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **83.975 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+16,1%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (5.510 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **United States of America** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Hong Kong International** the main route.



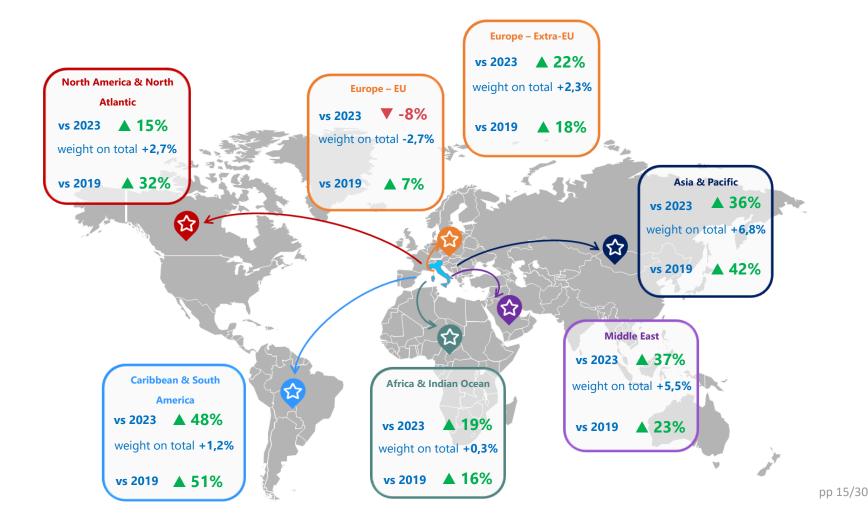


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#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +47,6% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,2%, meaning +839 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +6,8%, meaning +4.952 tons.

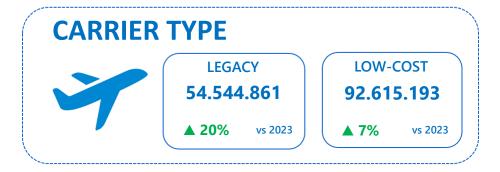


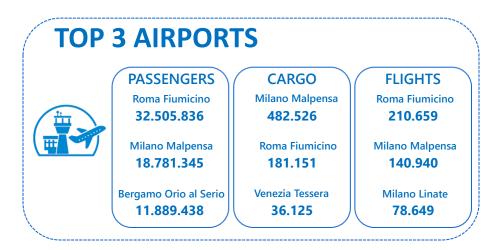

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.



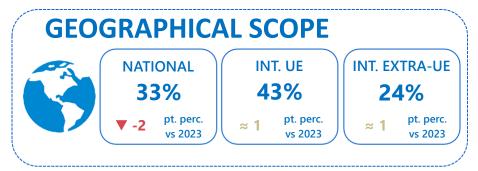


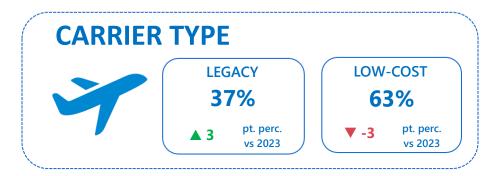


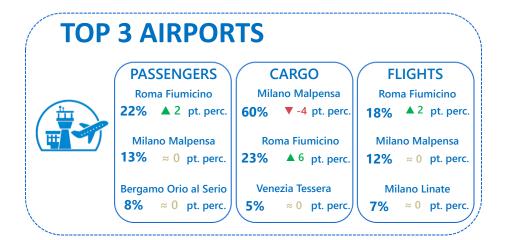

#### Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - August have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

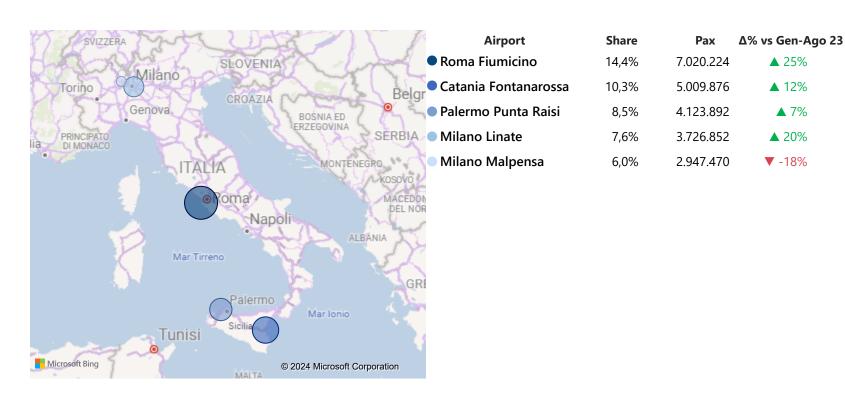
Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period **January - August** about **147,2 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+11,5%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+12,9%** compared to the period January - August 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - August** air traffic reached about **802,3 K tons**, recording an **increase** of **+17,4%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+16,7%** compared to January - August 2019.



#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

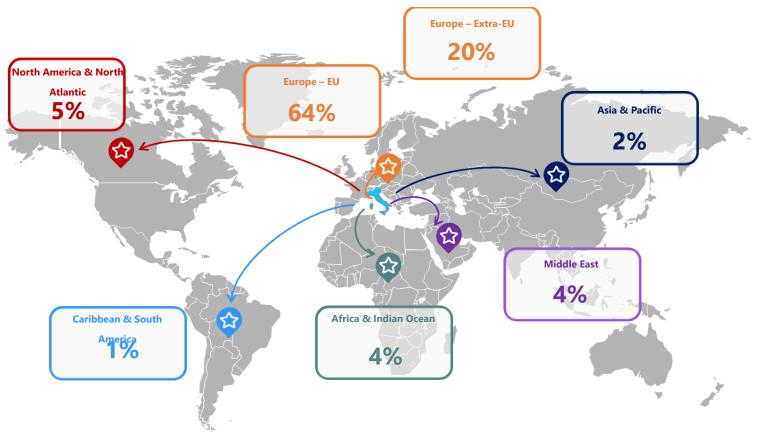
During the period January - August, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 48.781.410 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and an increase of +5,5% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **22.828.314 units**, accounting for the **47%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+10,8%** compared to January - August 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, witch matches to 7.020.224 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.





#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

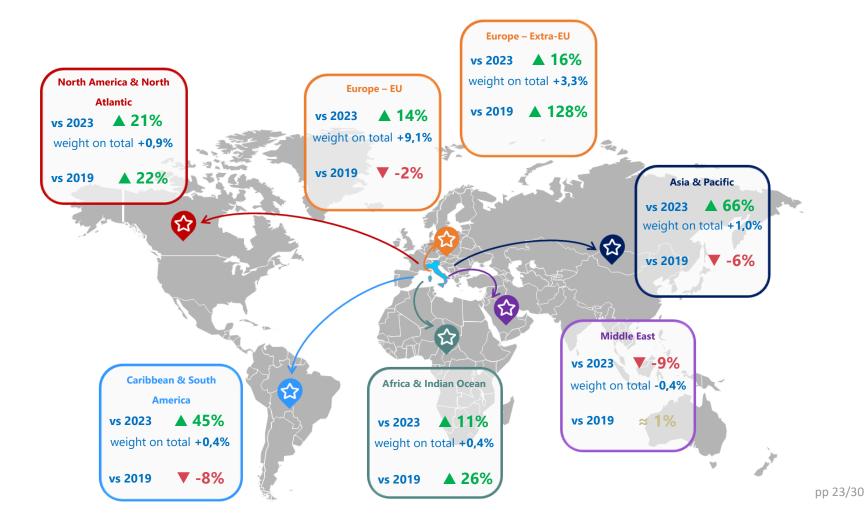
During the period January - January - August the **international passengers** traffic recorded **98.378.644 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+14,7%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (48.781.410 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas the main route.





#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +129,6% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,0%, meaning +35 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +9,1%, meaning +7.790.901 passengers.

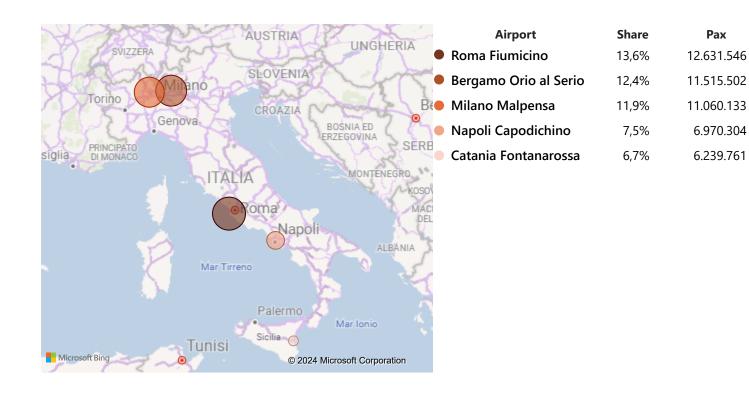




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#### **Low-cost Carriers**

During the period January - August the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 92.615.193 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of +7,0% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **48.417.246 units**, accounting for the **52%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,6% compared to January - August 2023. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 12.631.546 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino -Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

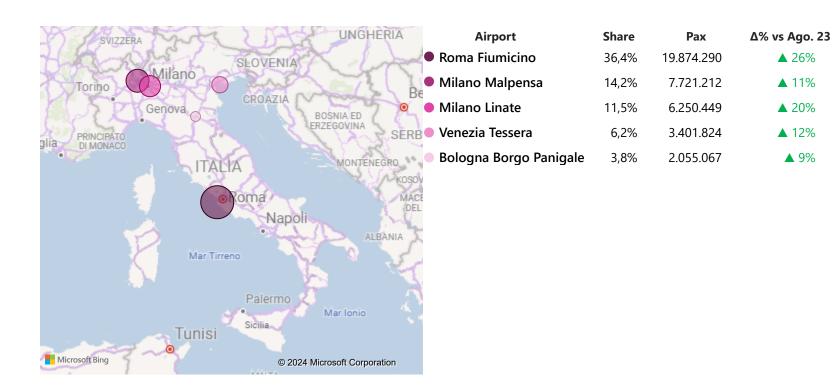

#### **Legacy Carriers**

During the period January - August the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 54.544.861 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of +20,1% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 3 percentage points. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **39.302.842 units**, accounting for the **72%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +19,7% compared to January - August 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 36%, which matches to 19.874.290 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

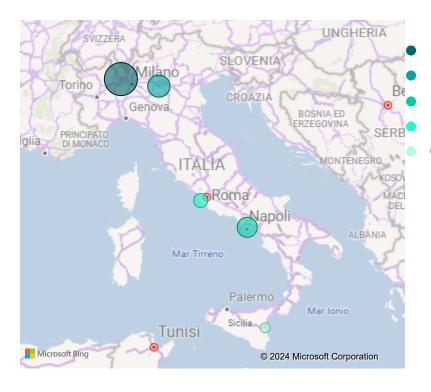

## Cargo – January - August 2024

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - August, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 51.381 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -14,9% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **33.663 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-19,1%** compared to January - August 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 30%, witch matches to 15.164 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.



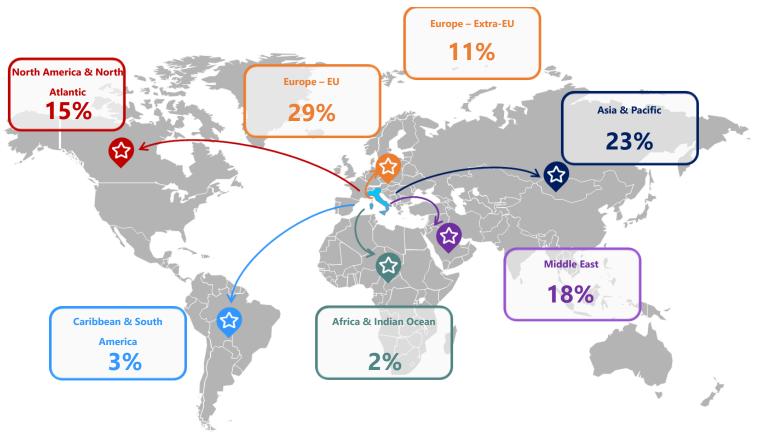

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - August the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **750.901 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+20,5%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (51.381 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.

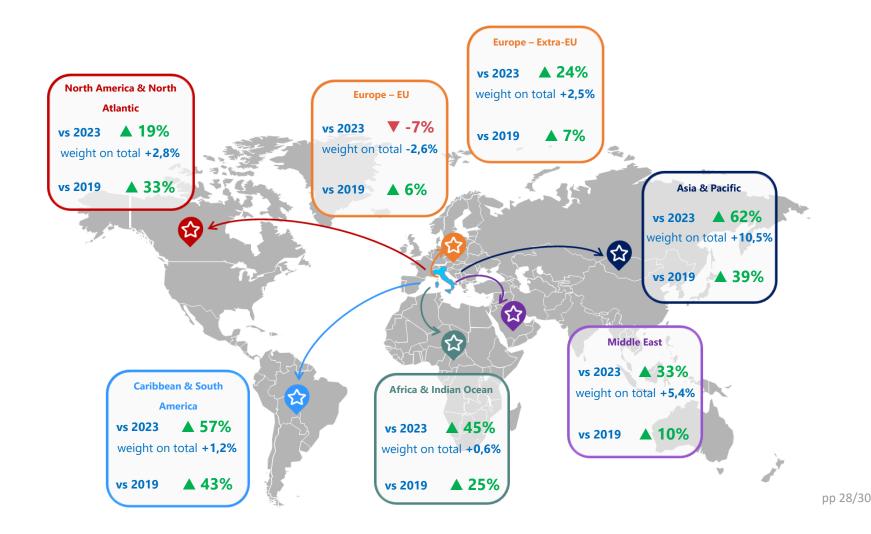

#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +62,2% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +10,5%, meaning +65.603 tons. Also in <u>relative</u> terms, **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +10,5%.
