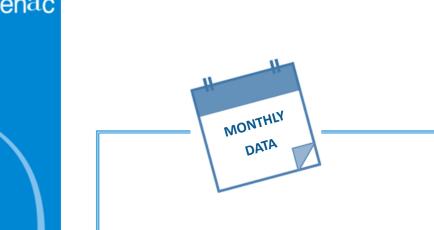

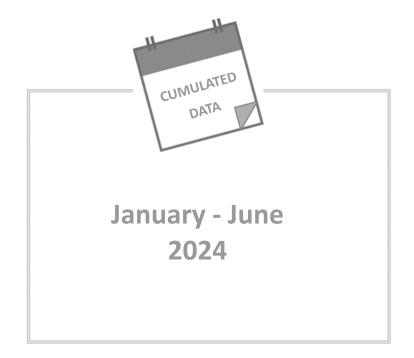

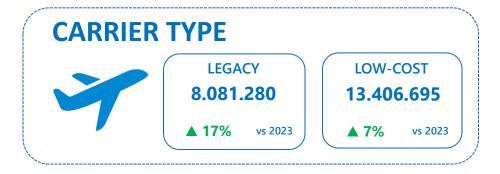






Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.



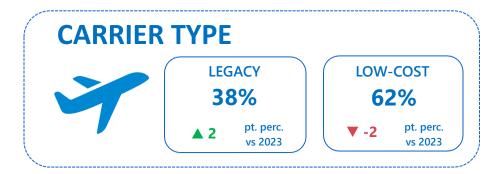


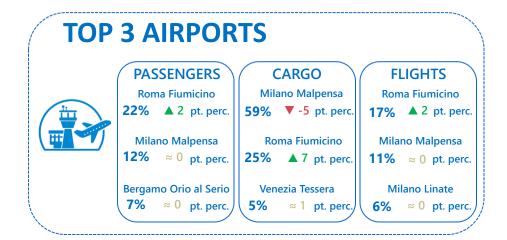




Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to June 2024 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during **June 2024** about **21,5 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+10,7%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+14,9%** compared to June 2019.

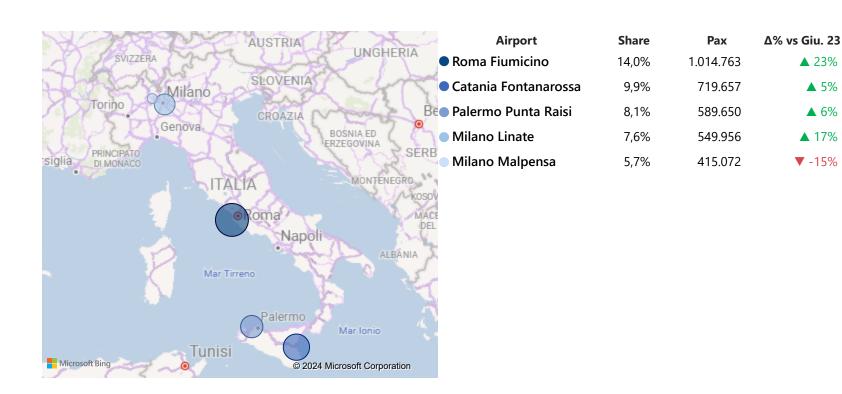
As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **June 2024** air traffic reached about **108,1 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+16,3%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+18,8%** compared to June 2019.



Passengers - June 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In June the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 7.238.222 units, corresponding to **34%** out of the total and an increase of +5,6% compared to the same period of the previous year. Top five airports reached a traffic of 3.289.098 units, accounting for the 45% out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of +8,7% compared to June. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 1.014.763 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.

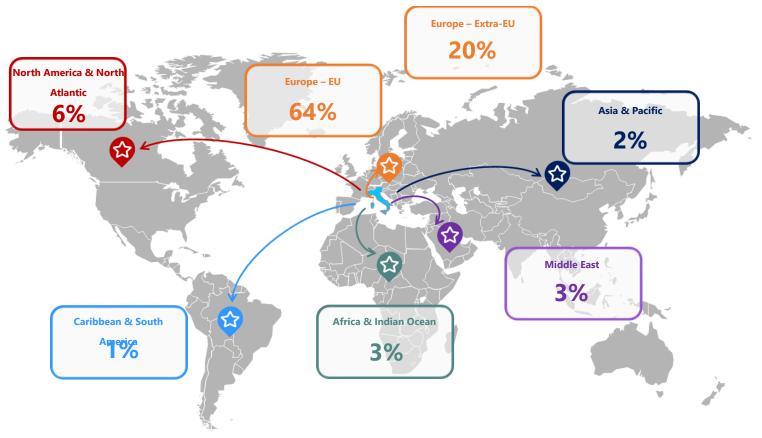

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In June the **international passengers** traffic recorded **14.249.753 units**, corresponding to **66%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+13,4%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.238.222 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.

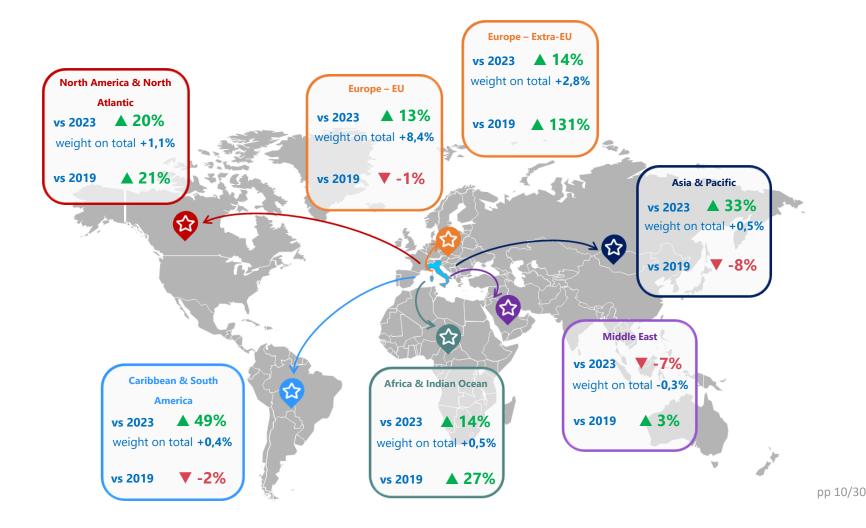




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International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America** area: +48,7%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,4%, meaning +44.572 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +8,4%, meaning +1.059.033 passengers.





Low-cost Carriers

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In June the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 13.406.695 units, corresponding to **62%** out of the total and an increase of **+7,2%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 2 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **6.724.466 units**, accounting for the **50%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,0% compared to June. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 13%, which matches to 1.731.433 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.





Passengers - June 2024

Legacy Carriers

In June the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 8.081.280 units, corresponding to **38%** out of the total and an increase of **+17,0%** compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 2 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **5.670.517 units**, accounting for the **70%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +15,4% compared to June 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 36%, which matches to 2.892.493 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - New York John F Kennedy Intl represent the main route.



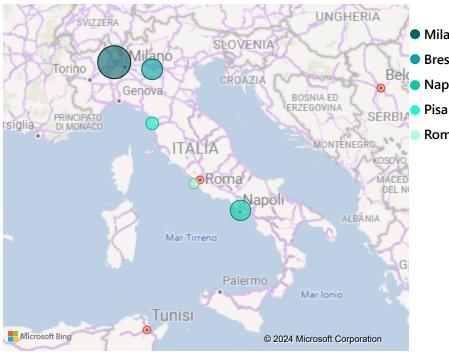

Cargo - June 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In June the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 6.646 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of total and a decrease of -14,8% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.437 tons**, accounting for the **67%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-17,2%** compared to June 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 30%, which matches to 2.025 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.



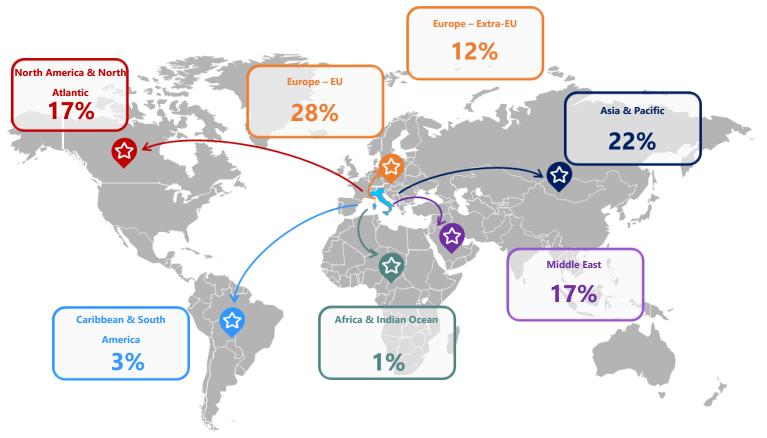

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In June the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **101.487 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+19,2%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (6.646 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **United States of America** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.

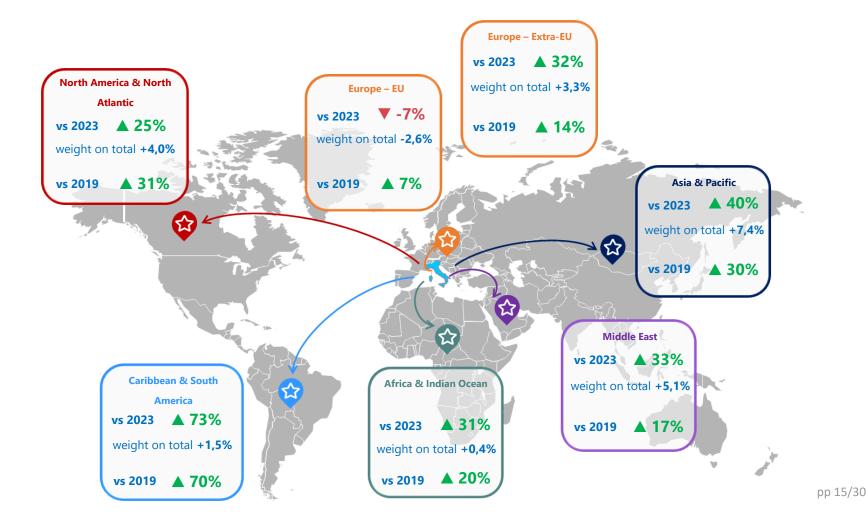




Cargo - June 2024

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +72,9% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,5%, meaning +1.272 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +7,4%, meaning +6.332 tons.

Cumulative traffic since the beginning of the year





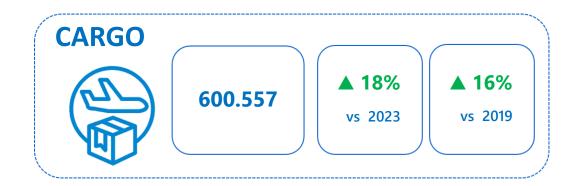

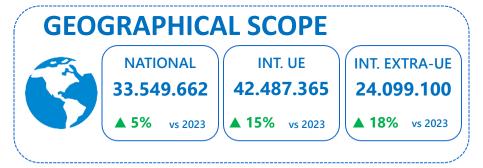


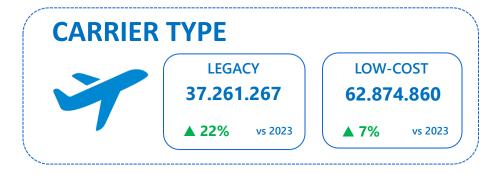


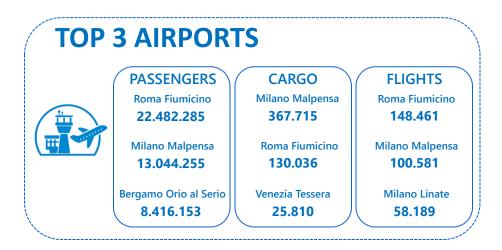




Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.

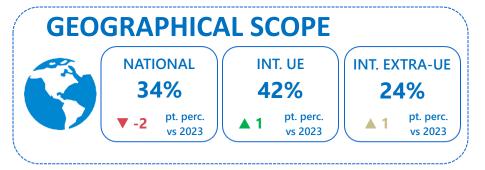




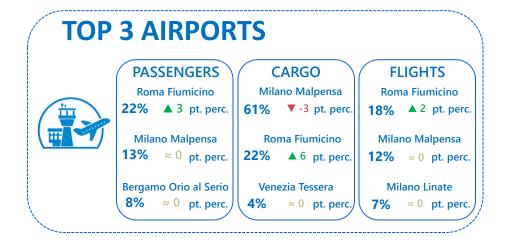




Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - June have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period **January - June** about **100,1 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+11,9%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+12,0%** compared to the period January - June 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - June** air traffic reached about **600,6 K tons**, recording an **increase** of **+18,0%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+16,4%** compared to January - June 2019.



National Scope - Top-5 Airports

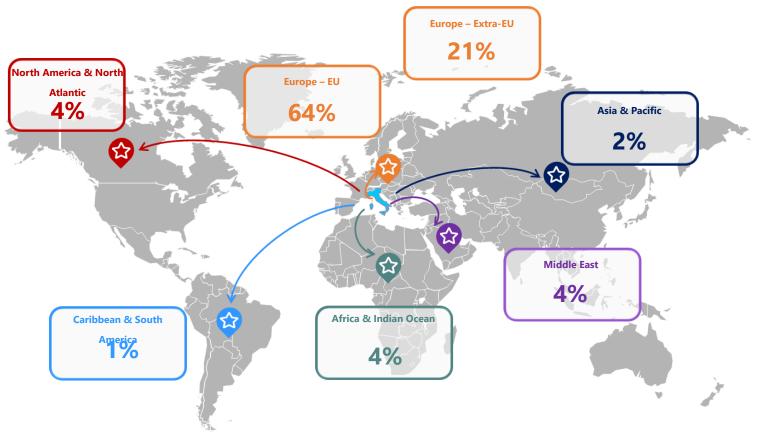
During the period January - June, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 33.549.662 units, corresponding to **34%** out of the total and an increase of +4,9% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **16.157.387 units**, accounting for the **48%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+9,9%** compared to January - June 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 15%, witch matches to 4.919.151 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.





International Scope - Share by geographical area

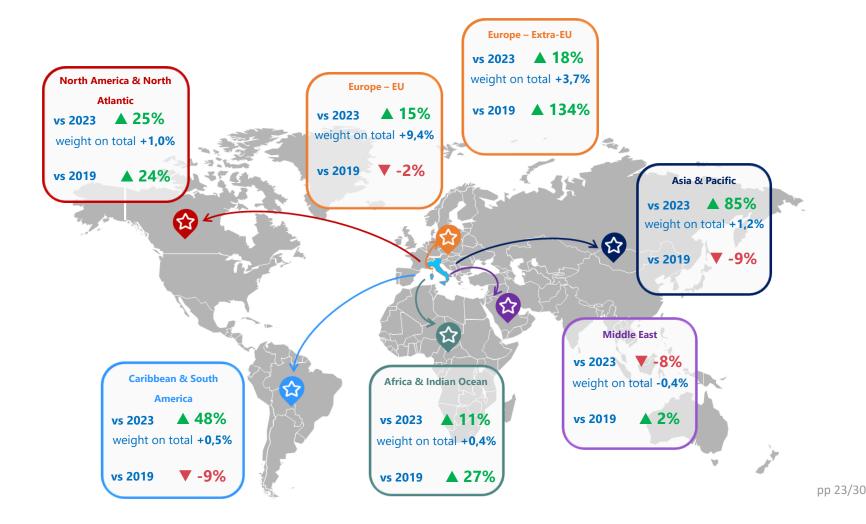
During the period January - January - June the **international passengers** traffic recorded **66.586.465 units**, corresponding to **66%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+15,8%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (33.549.662 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +84,9% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,2%, meaning +685.630 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +9,4%, meaning +5.422.498 passengers.



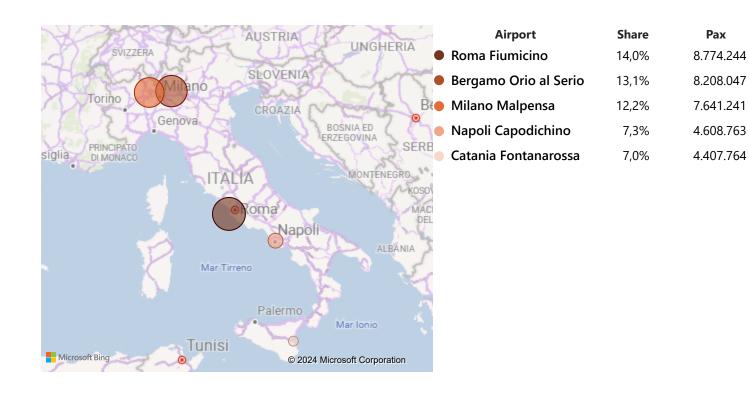


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Passengers – January - June 2024

Low-cost Carriers

During the period January - June the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 62.874.860 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of **+6,7%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **33.640.059 units**, accounting for the **54%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,0% compared to January - June 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 8.774.244 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

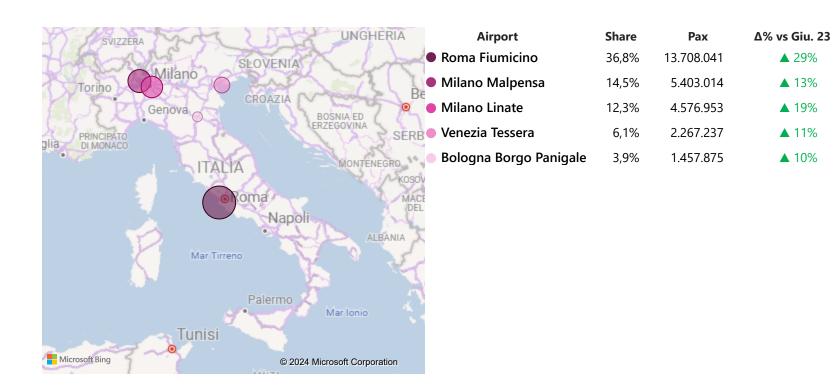

Legacy Carriers

During the period January - June the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 37.261.267 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of +21,8% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 3 percentage points . Top five airports reached a traffic of 27.413.120 units, accounting for the 74% out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +21,4% compared to January - June 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 13.708.041 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

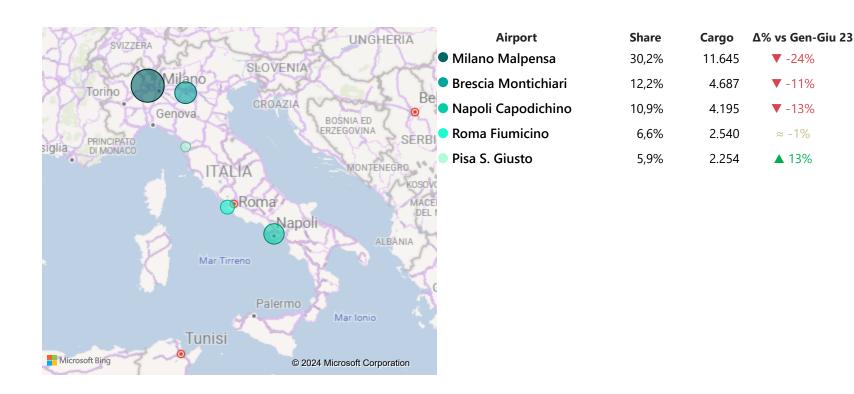

Cargo – January - June 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - June, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 38.527 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -17,5% compared to the same period of last year. Top five airports reached a traffic of 25.321 tons, accounting for the 66% out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of -21,7% compared to January - June 2023. Milano Malpensa is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 30%, witch matches to 11.645 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.

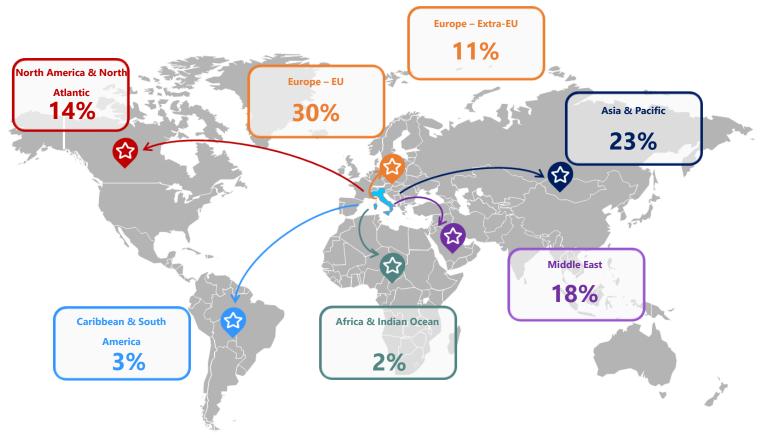

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - June the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **562.030 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+21,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (38.527 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.

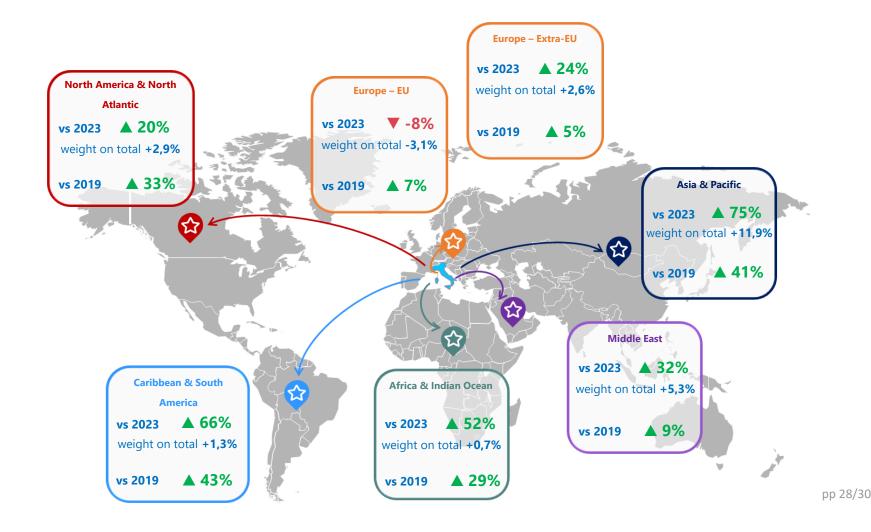




Cargo – January - June 2024

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +74,6% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +11,9%, meaning +54.988 tons. Also in <u>relative</u> terms, **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +11,9%.
