











Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.










Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to October 2024 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during **October 2024** about **20,1 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+9,3%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+19,1%** compared to October 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **October 2024** air traffic reached about **111,0 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+11,9%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+12,1%** compared to October 2019.



Passengers - October 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In October the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 6.445.328 units, corresponding to **32%** out of the total and an increase of +4,3% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.056.999 units**, accounting for the **47%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+6,9%** compared to October. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 913.945 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.



Passengers - October 2024

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In October the **international passengers** traffic recorded **13.702.256 units**, corresponding to **68%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+11,8%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (6.445.328 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.



International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Vettore non noto** area: **+49,6%**, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,0%, meaning **+67** passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: **+7,5%**, meaning **+917.791** passengers.







Low-cost Carriers

In October the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 12.783.266 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of **+7,8%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has remained essentially unchanged. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **6.729.493 units**, accounting for the **53%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,8% compared to October. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 1.775.865 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

Legacy Carriers

In October the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 7.364.318 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of **+11,9%** compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has remained essentially unchanged. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **5.378.413 units**, accounting for the **73%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,8% compared to October 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 2.703.160 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.






Cargo - October 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In October the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 7.488 tons, corresponding to **7%** out of total and an increase of +5,6% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.911 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with an increase of **+3,8%** compared to October 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 28%, which matches to 2.131 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.





International Scope - Share by geographical area

In October the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **103.498 tons**, corresponding to **93%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+12,4%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.488 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Hong Kong International** the main route.



Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +34,3% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +6,9%, meaning +6.308 tons. Also in <u>relative</u> terms the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +6,9%.






Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.











The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - October have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period **January - October** about **189,2 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+11,1%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+13,9%** compared to the period January - October 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - October** air traffic reached about **1014,6 K tons**, recording an **increase** of **+16,1%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+16,0%** compared to January - October 2019.



National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - October, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 62.347.184 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and an increase of +5,6% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of 29.138.336 units, accounting for the 47% out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,4% compared to January - October 2023. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, witch matches to 8.938.052 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.



International Scope - Share by geographical area


During the period January - January - October the **international passengers** traffic recorded **126.902.159 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+14,1%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (62.347.184 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +120,6% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,0%, meaning +41 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +8,8%, meaning +9.743.901 passengers.





Low-cost Carriers

During the period January - October the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 119.100.867 units, corresponding to 63% out of the total and an increase of +7,2% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 2 percentage points . Top five airports reached a traffic of 62.147.809 units, accounting for the 52% out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,5% compared to January - October 2023. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 16.217.349 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino -Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.



Legacy Carriers

During the period January - October the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 70.148.476 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of **+18,6%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 2 percentage points. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **50.374.318 units**, accounting for the **72%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +18,1% compared to January - October 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 36%, which matches to 25.486.998 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.





Cargo – January - October 2024

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - October, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 65.572 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -11,4% compared to the same period of last year. Top five airports reached a traffic of 42.864 tons, accounting for the 65% out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of -15,2% compared to January -October 2023. Milano Malpensa is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 29%, witch matches to 19.115 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.





International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - October the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **949.010 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+18,7%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (65.572 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.






Cargo – January - October 2024

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +55,0% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +9,6%, meaning +76.954 tons. Also in <u>relative</u> terms, **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +9,6%.
