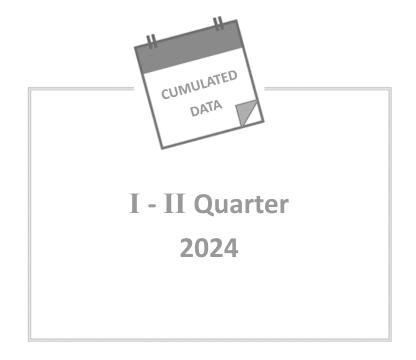

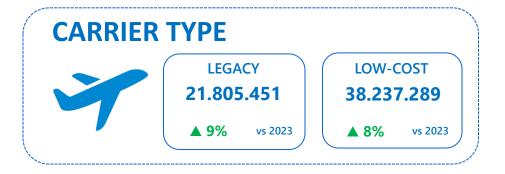

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.

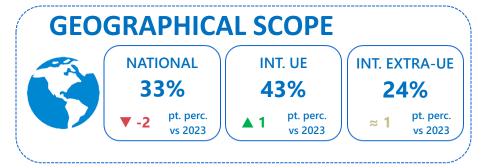


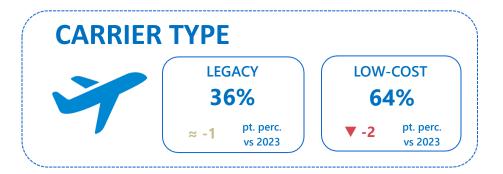


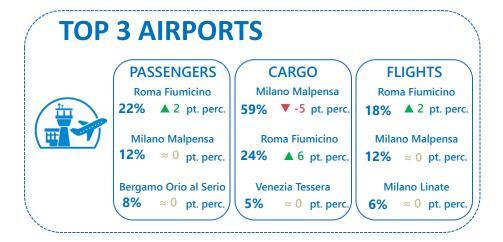




Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









#### Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to II Quarter 2024 have been compared to the same period of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during II Quarter 2024 about 60,0 M of persons have been moved, recording an increase of +11,8% compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +15,6% compared to II Quarter 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during II Quarter 2024 air traffic reached about 318,5 K tons, recording an increase del +18,8% compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +17,7% compared to II Quarter 2019.



#### Passengers – II Quarter 2024

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the II Quarter the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 19.851.717 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and an increase of +5,4% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **9.232.218 units**, accounting for the **47%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+9,0%** compared to II Quarter 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 2.772.336 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.

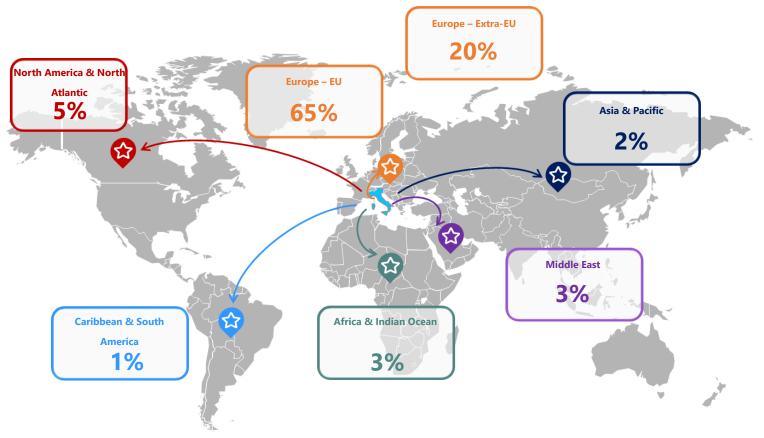

#### Passengers – II Quarter 2024

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the II Quarter the **international passengers** traffic recorded **40.191.023 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+15,3%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (19.851.717 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.

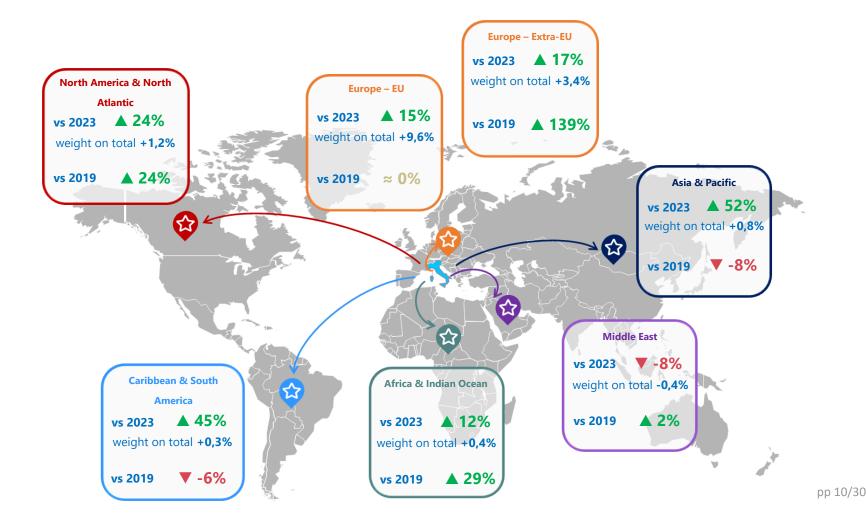




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#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: +52,3%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,8%, meaning +269.598 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +9,6%, meaning +3.339.307 passengers.

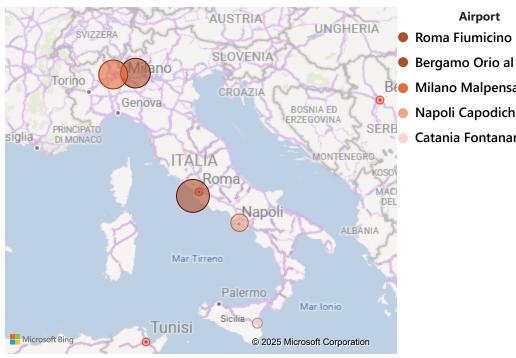




## Low-cost Carriers

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During the II Quarter the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 38.237.289 units, corresponding to **64%** out of the total and an increase of **+8,0%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 2 percentage points. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **19.677.446 units**, accounting for the **51%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,4% compared to II Quarter 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 5.205.742 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

## Legacy Carriers

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During II Quarter the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 21.805.451 units, corresponding to **36%** out of the total and an increase of **+8,9%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has remained essentially unchanged. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **15.664.951 units**, accounting for the **72%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,7% compared to II Quarter 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 36%, which matches to 7.930.515 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - New York John F Kennedy Intl represent the main route.

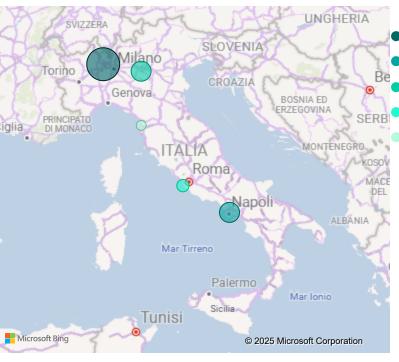

#### Cargo – II Quarter 2024

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During II Quarter the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 19.736 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of total and a decrease of -12,0% compared to the same month of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **12.974 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-16,1%** compared to II Quarter 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 30%, which matches to 5.981 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.



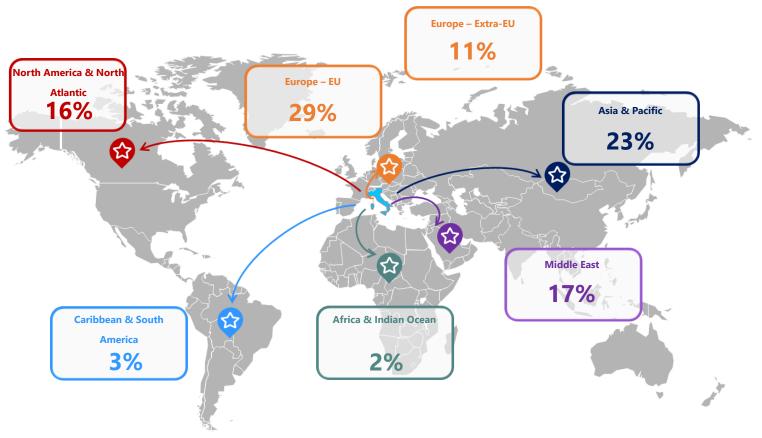

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

During II Quarter the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **298.786 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+21,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (19.736 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **United States of America** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.

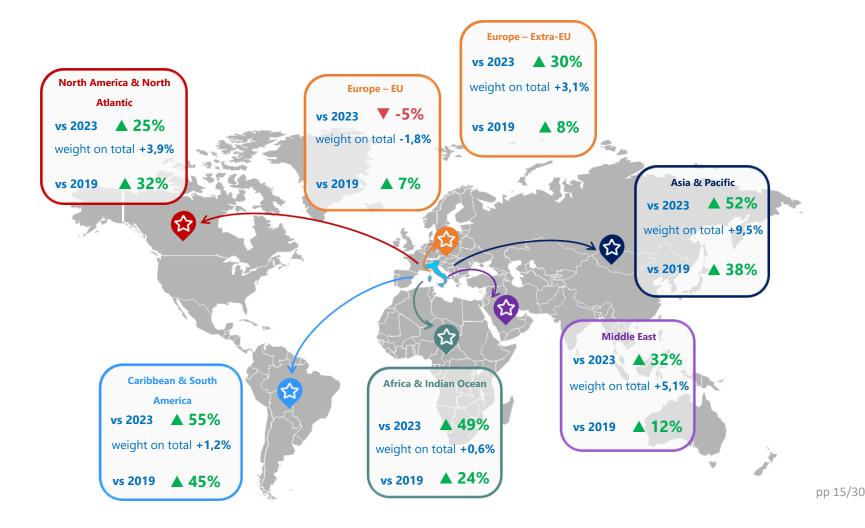




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#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

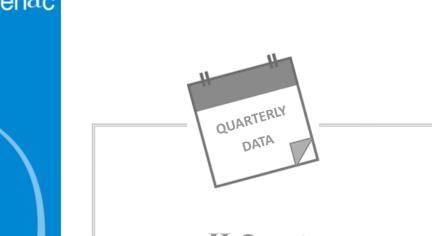
Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +55,1% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,2%, meaning +2.864 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +9,5%, meaning +23.338 tons.

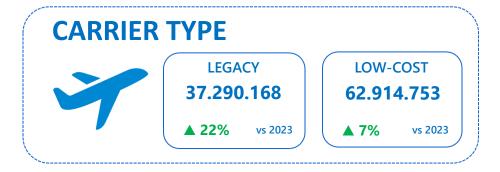


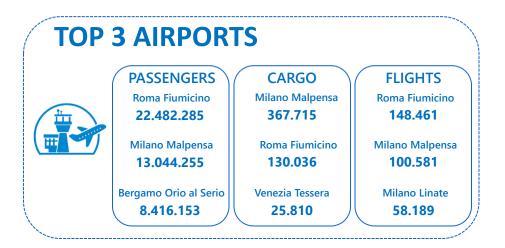




Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.

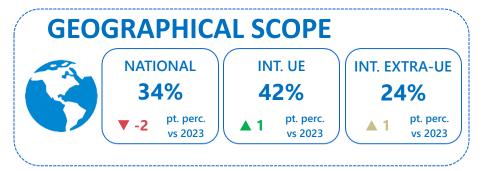




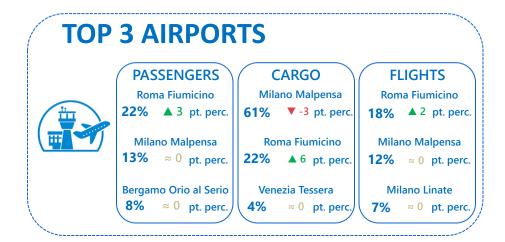




Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









#### Comparison to same period 2023 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period I - II Quarter have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2023) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period I - II Quarter about 100,2 M of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of +12,0% compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +12,1% compared to the period I - II Quarter 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period I - II Quarter air traffic reached about 600,6 K tons, recording an increase of +18,0% compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +16,4% compared to January - I - II Quarter 2019.



#### Passengers – I - II Quarter 2024

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period I - II Quarter, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 33.594.511 units, corresponding to **34%** out of the total and an increase of +5,0% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **16.157.387 units**, accounting for the **48%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+9,9%** compared to I - II Quarter 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 15%, witch matches to 4.919.151 passengers. Connections Catania Fontanarossa - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.

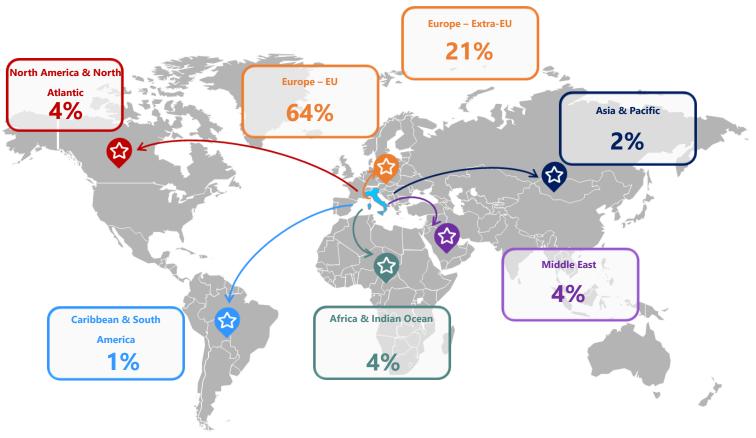

#### Passengers – I - II Quarter 2024

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period I - II Quarter the **international passengers** traffic recorded **66.610.410 units**, corresponding to **66%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+15,9%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (33.594.511 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.



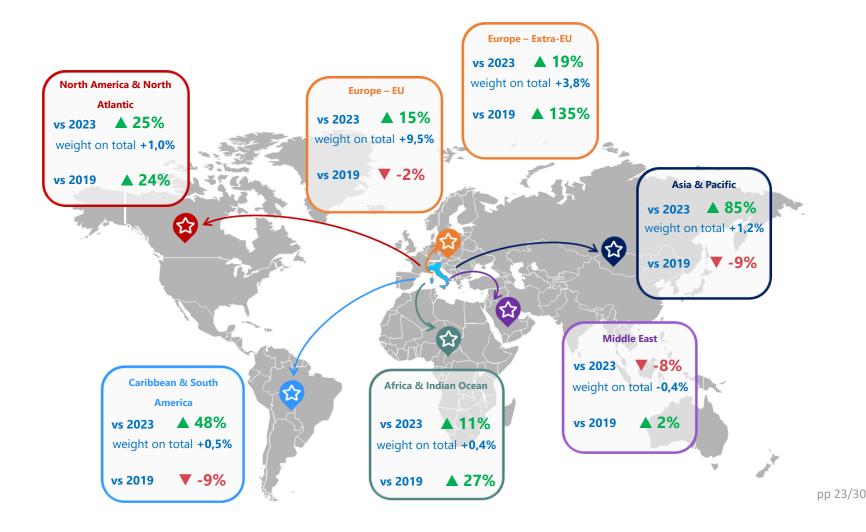


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#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +84,9% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,2%, meaning +685.646 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +9,5%, meaning +5.433.323 passengers.





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#### **Low-cost Carriers**

During the period I - II Quarter the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 62.914.753 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of **+6,8%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **33.640.059 units**, accounting for the **53%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +11,0% compared to I - II Quarter 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 8.774.244 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

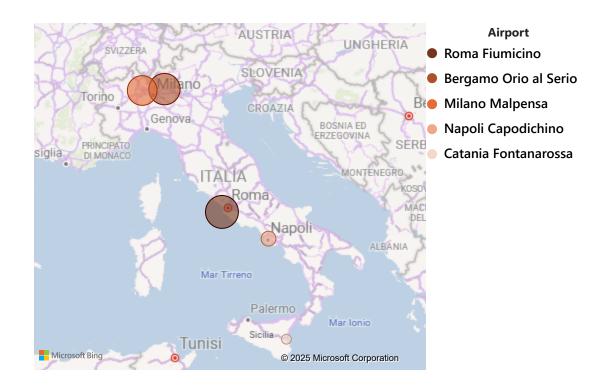

#### **Legacy Carriers**

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During the period I - II Quarter the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 37.290.168 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of **+21,9%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 3 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **27.413.120 units**, accounting for the **74%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +21,4% compared to I - II Quarter 2023. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 13.708.041 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

#### National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period I - II Quarter, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 38.528 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -17,5% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **25.321 tons**, accounting for the **66%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-21,7%** compared to I - II Quarter 2023. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 30%, witch matches to 11.645 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.

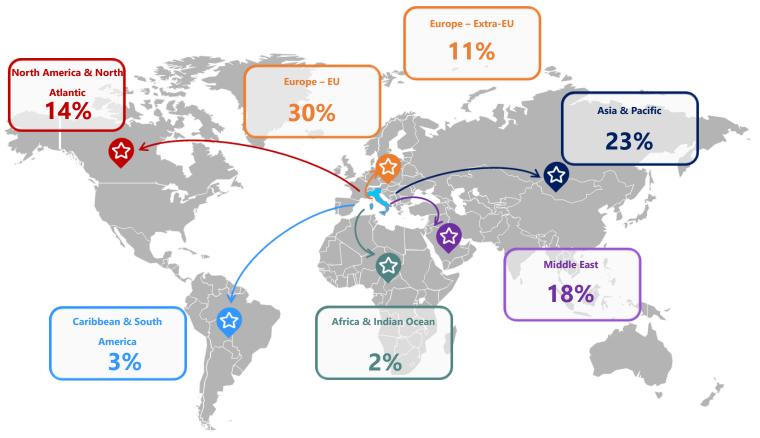

#### International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period I - II Quarter the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **562.030 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+21,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (38.528 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.

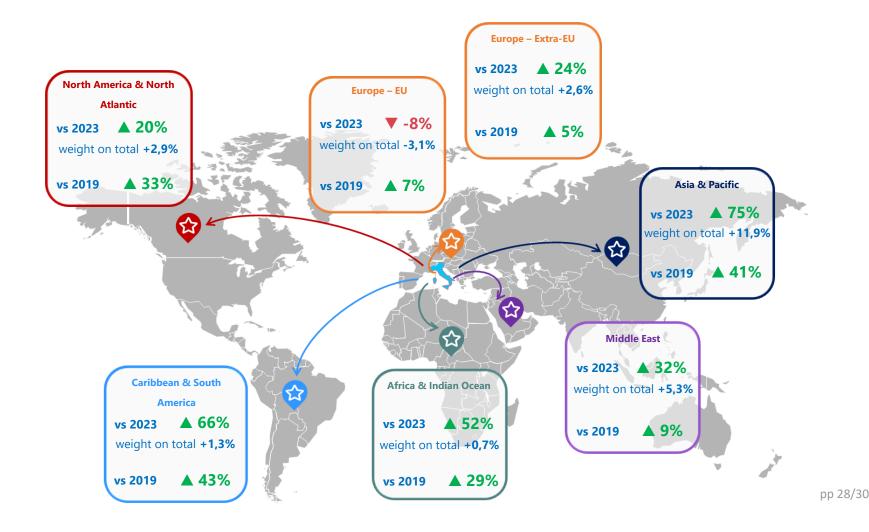




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#### International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area
