







Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Key data – IV Quarter 2023

Comparison to same period 2022 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to IV Quarter 2023 have been compared to the same period of the previous year (2022) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during IV Quarter 2023 about 45,3 M of persons have been moved, recording an increase of +14,0% compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +4,0% compared to IV Quarter 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during IV Quarter 2023 air traffic reached about 287,1 K tons, recording an increase del +5,1% compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +0,2% compared to IV Quarter 2019.



Passengers – IV Quarter 2023

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the IV Quarter the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 15.759.655 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of +4,2% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **7.712.607 units**, accounting for the **49%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+8,8%** compared to IV Quarter 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 15%, which matches to 2.311.177 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.



International Scope - Share by geographical area


During the IV Quarter the **international passengers** traffic recorded **29.492.424 units**, corresponding to **65%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+20,0%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (15.759.655 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area


Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: **+199,8%**, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by **+1,7%**, meaning **+413.311** passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: **+11,5%**, meaning **+2.833.814** passengers.





Low-cost Carriers

During the IV Quarter the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 28.296.901 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of **+7,3%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 4 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **15.340.779 units**, accounting for the **54%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +12,3% compared to IV Quarter 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 3.859.220 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

During IV Quarter the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 16.955.178 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of **+16,5%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has remained essentially unchanged. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **12.636.329 units**, accounting for the **75%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +20,9% compared to IV Quarter 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 37%, which matches to 6.284.734 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.





Cargo – IV Quarter 2023

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During IV Quarter the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 20.984 tons, corresponding to **7%** out of total and a decrease of -19,4% compared to the same month of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **13.982 tons**, accounting for the **67%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-23,2%** compared to IV Quarter 2022. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 30%, which matches to 6.209 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.





International Scope - Share by geographical area


During IV Quarter the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **266.075 tons**, corresponding to **93%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+7,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (20.984 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +46,7% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +7,5%, meaning +18.629 tons. Also in <u>relative</u> terms the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +7,5%.









Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.











Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.









Comparison to same period 2022 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period I - IV Quarter have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2022) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period I - IV Quarter about 197,1 M of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of +19,7% compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector has recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a positive trend of +2,3% compared to the period I - IV Quarter 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period I - IV Quarter air traffic reached about 1061,7 K tons, recording a decrease of -1,4% compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector has not recovered pre-Pandemic values, with a negative trend of -0,1% compared to January - I - IV Quarter 2019.

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period I - IV Quarter, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 68.638.581 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of +6,3% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **31.237.935 units**, accounting for the **46%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+8,8%** compared to I - IV Quarter 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 13%, witch matches to 8.735.699 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.



International Scope - Share by geographical area


During the period I - IV Quarter the **international passengers** traffic recorded **128.490.148 units**, corresponding to **65%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+28,3%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (68.638.581 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +323,8% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,6%, meaning +1.619.058 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +15,2%, meaning +15.256.991 passengers.





Low-cost Carriers

During the period I - IV Quarter the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 127.582.279 units, corresponding to **65%** out of the total and an increase of **+11,4%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 5 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **64.997.076 units**, accounting for the **51%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +15,2% compared to I - IV Quarter 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 12%, which matches to 15.807.507 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.



Legacy Carriers

During the period I - IV Quarter the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 69.546.450 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of **+38,5%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 5 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **50.500.263 units**, accounting for the **73%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +41,0% compared to I - IV Quarter 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 35%, which matches to 24.506.396 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period I - IV Quarter, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 87.869 tons, corresponding to **8%** out of the total and a decrease of -13,2% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **59.572 tons**, accounting for the **68%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-14,7%** compared to I - IV Quarter 2022. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 32%, witch matches to 27.713 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.





During the period I - IV Quarter the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **973.800 tons**, corresponding to **92%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is **steady values**, with a variation of **-,1%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (87.869 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Leipzig-Halle** the main route.



Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +53,9% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,8%, meaning +7.387 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, **Asia & Pacific** as been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +2,4%, meaning +23.638 tons.
