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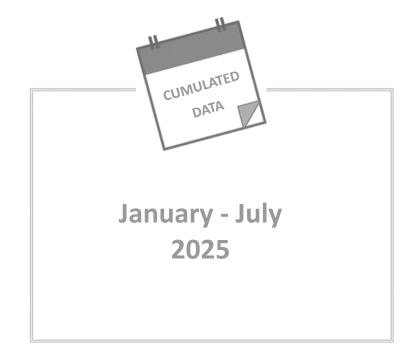

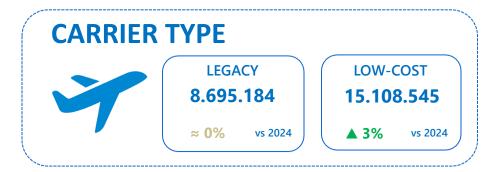


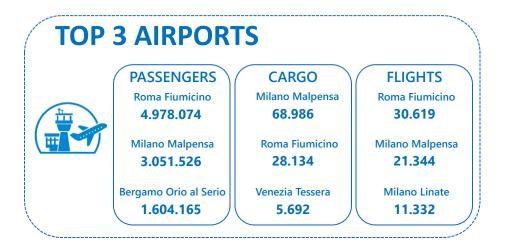

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.







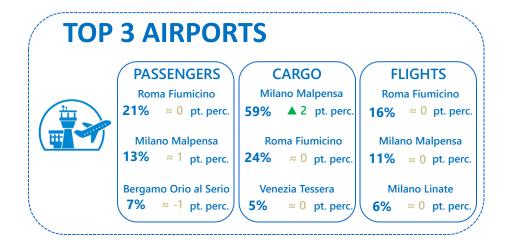

Comparison to same period 2024 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to July 2025 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2024) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during **July 2025** about **23,8 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+1,8%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+16,5%** compared to July 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **July 2025** air traffic reached about **116,7 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+4,0%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+18,3%** compared to July 2019.



Passengers - July 2025

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In July the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 7.448.282 units, corresponding to **31%** out of the total and a decrease of -3,7% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.232.458 units**, accounting for the **43%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with una flessione del **-5,9%** compared to July. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 1.021.384 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.



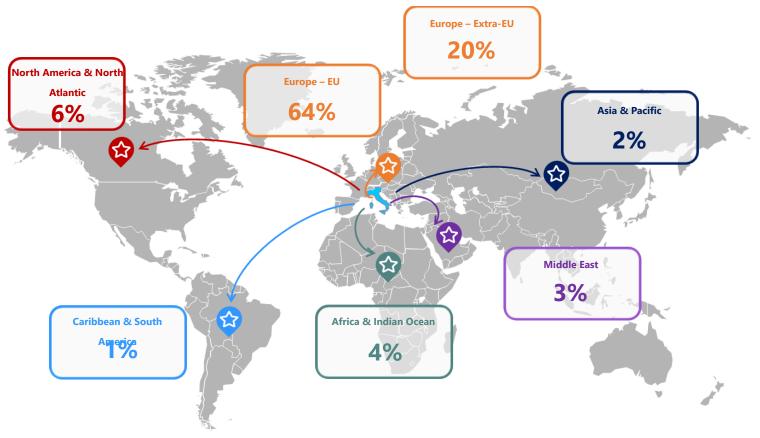

International Scope - Share by geographical area

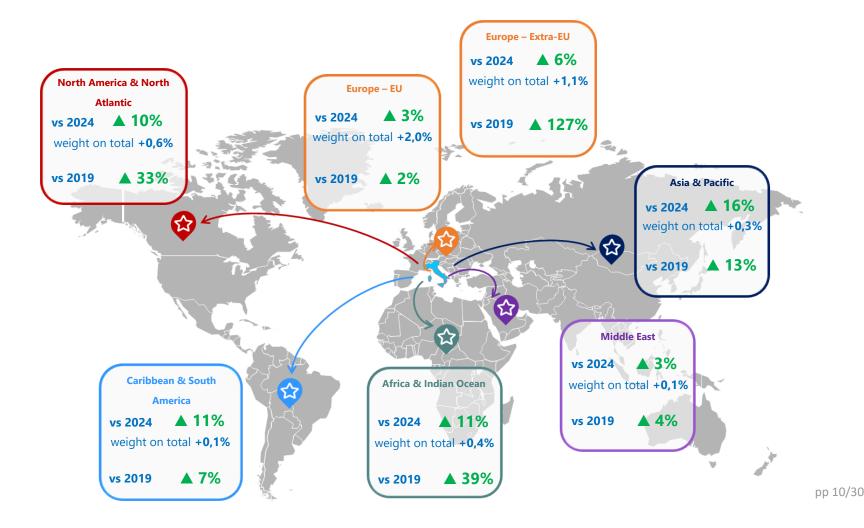
In July the **international passengers** traffic recorded **16.355.447 units**, corresponding to **69%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+4,5%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.448.282 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: +31,6%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,0%, meaning +06 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +2,0%, meaning +306.049 passengers.





Low-cost Carriers

In July the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 15.108.545 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of **+2,6%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has remained essentially unchanged. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **7.302.341 units**, accounting for the **48%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with steady values -0,1% compared to July. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 13%, which matches to 1.924.481 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.





Legacy Carriers

In July the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 8.695.184 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and steady values with a variation of $\pm 0.4\%$ compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has remained essentially unchanged . Top five airports reached a traffic of **6.026.418 units**, accounting for the **69%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with valori stabili con una variaizone del -0,1% compared to July 2024. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 35%, which matches to 3.053.593 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - New York John F Kennedy Intl represent the main route.

Cargo - July 2025

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In July the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 7.056 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of total and a decrease of -3,9% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.790 tons**, accounting for the **68%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with steady values, with a variation of **+0,7%** compared to July 2024. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 29%, which matches to 2.058 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.



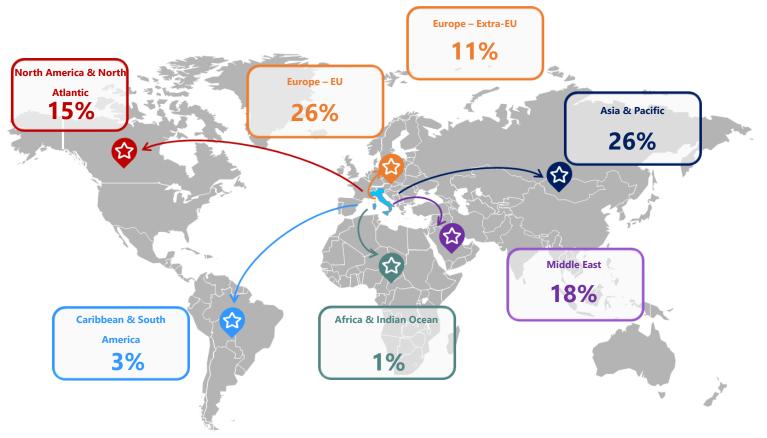

International Scope - Share by geographical area

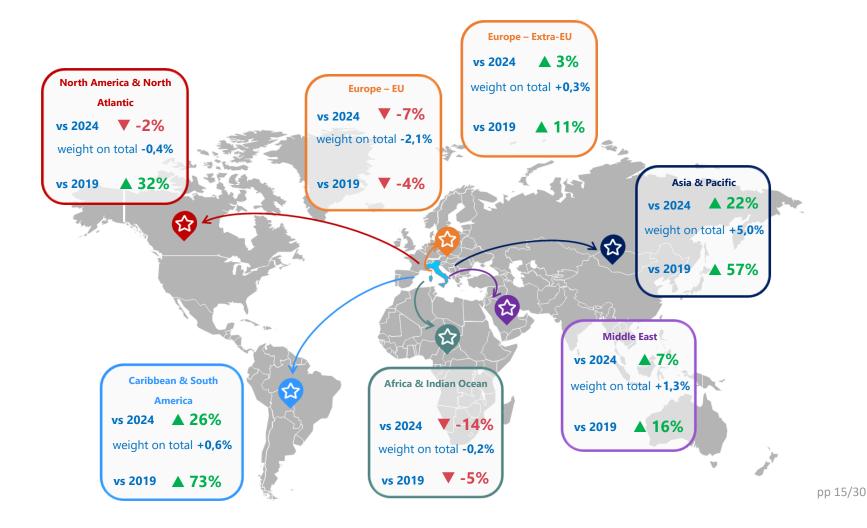
In July the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **109.683 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+4,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.056 tons). The **Asia & Pacific** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Hong Kong International** the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +25,5% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,6%, meaning +670 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: +5,0%, meaning +5.259 tons.

Cumulative traffic since the beginning of the year









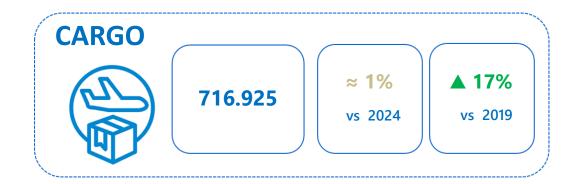

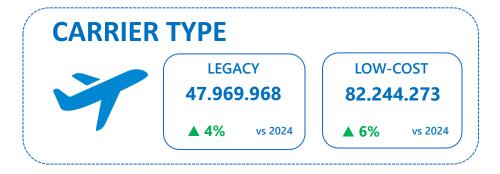


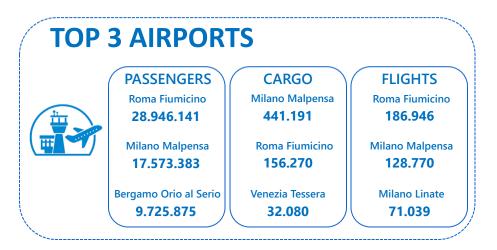

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.





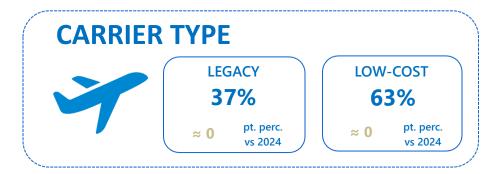


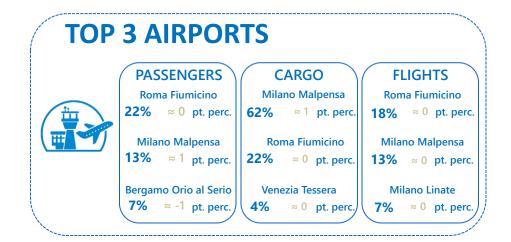

Key data – January - July 2025

Comparison to same period 2024 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - July have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2024) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period **January - July** about **130,2 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+5,4%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+18,6%** compared to the period January - July 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - July** air traffic reached about **716,9 K tons**, recording **steady values**, with a variation of **+0,6%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+16,7%** compared to January - July 2019.



National Scope - Top-5 Airports

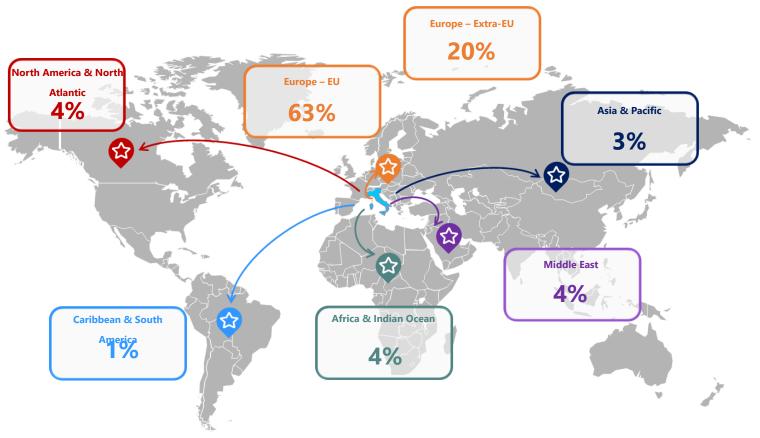
During the period January - July, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 41.748.833 units, corresponding to **32%** out of the total and an increase of +1,0% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **19.326.141 units**, accounting for the **46%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with a decrease of **-1,4%** compared to January - July 2024. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, witch matches to 6.004.786 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.





International Scope - Share by geographical area

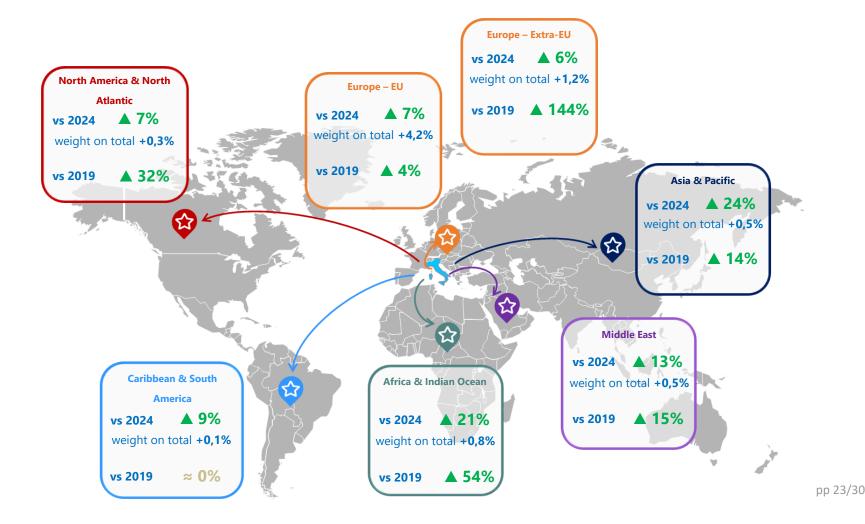
During the period January - January - July the **international passengers** traffic recorded **88.465.408 units**, corresponding to **68%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+7,5%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (41.748.833 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +23,5% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,5%, meaning +422.573 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +4,2%, meaning +3.429.073 passengers.







Low-cost Carriers

During the period January - July the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 82.244.273 units, corresponding to **63%** out of the total and an increase of **+5,9%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has remained essentially unchanged . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **42.413.092 units**, accounting for the **52%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +3,6% compared to January - July 2024. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 14%, which matches to 11.459.681 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

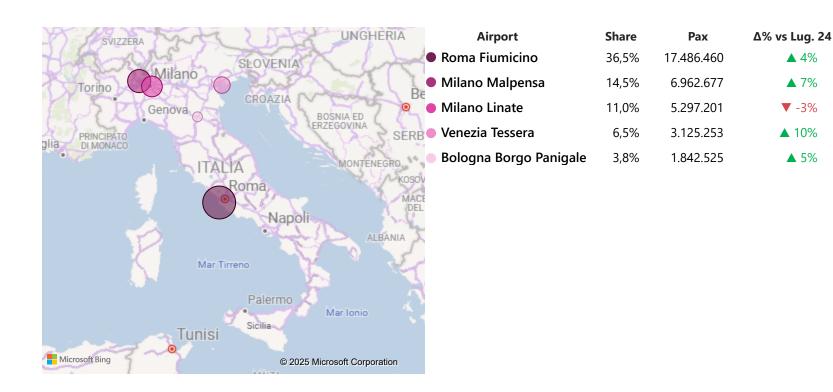

Legacy Carriers

During the period January - July the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 47.969.968 units, corresponding to **37%** out of the total and an increase of +4,4% compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has remained essentially unchanged . Top five airports reached a traffic of 34.714.116 units, accounting for the 72% out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +4,0% compared to January - July 2024. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 36%, which matches to 17.486.460 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

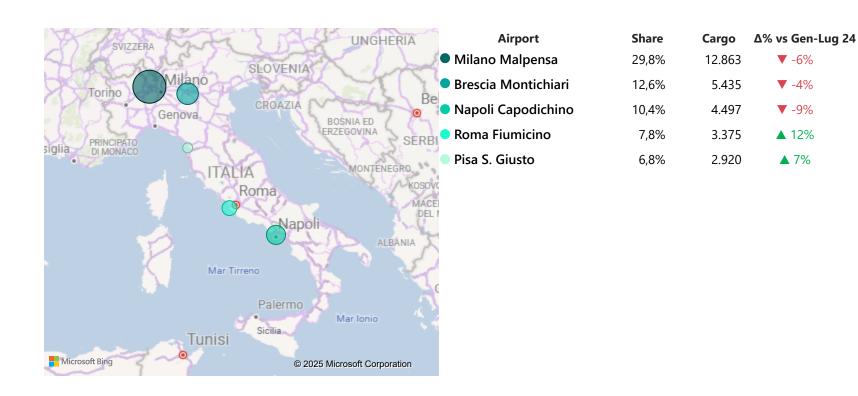

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - July, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 43.145 tons, corresponding to **6%** out of the total and a decrease of -5,9% compared to the same period of last year. Top five airports reached a traffic of 29.091 tons, accounting for the 67% out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of -3,3% compared to January - July 2024. Milano Malpensa is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 30%, witch matches to 12.863 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.

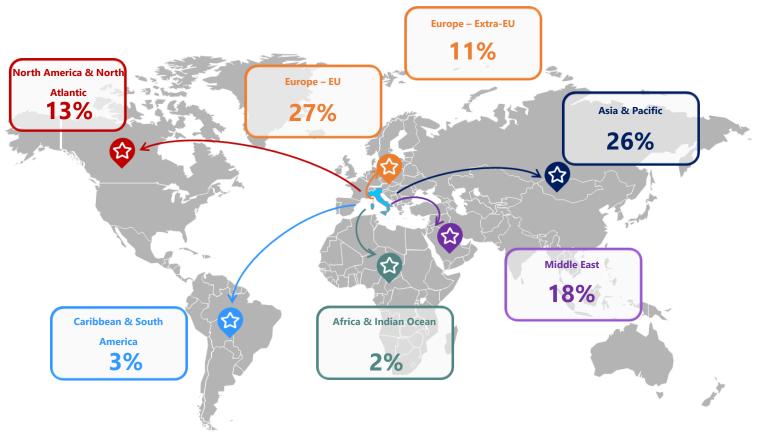

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - July the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **673.780 tons**, corresponding to **94%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+1,0%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (43.145 tons). The **Europe** - **EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa** - **Hong Kong International** the main route.

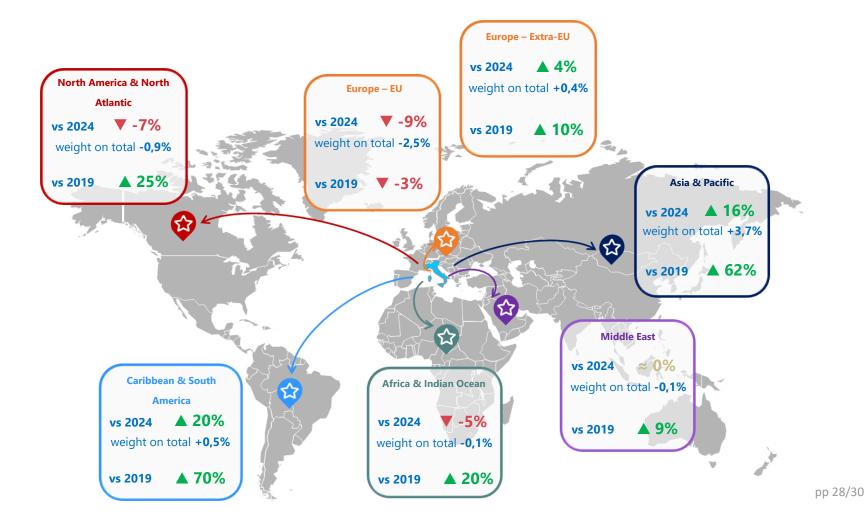




Cargo – January - July 2025

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: **+19,8%** area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by **+0,5%**, meaning **+3.466** tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, **Asia & Pacific** as been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: **+3,7%**, meaning **+24.939** tons.
