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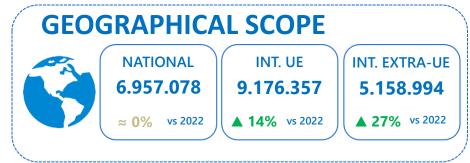


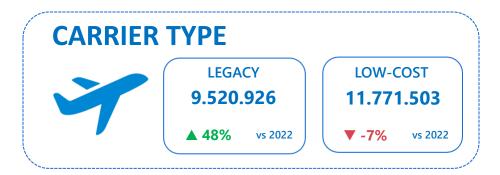


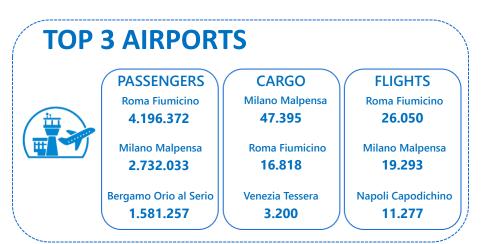




Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.



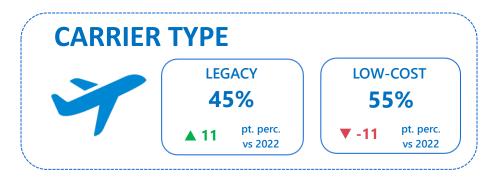


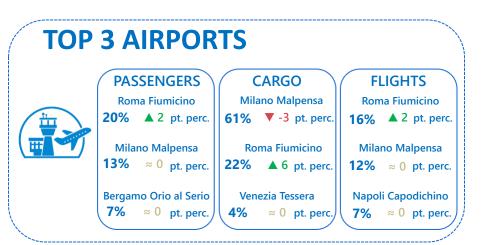




Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.













Comparison to same period 2022 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to August 2023 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2022) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

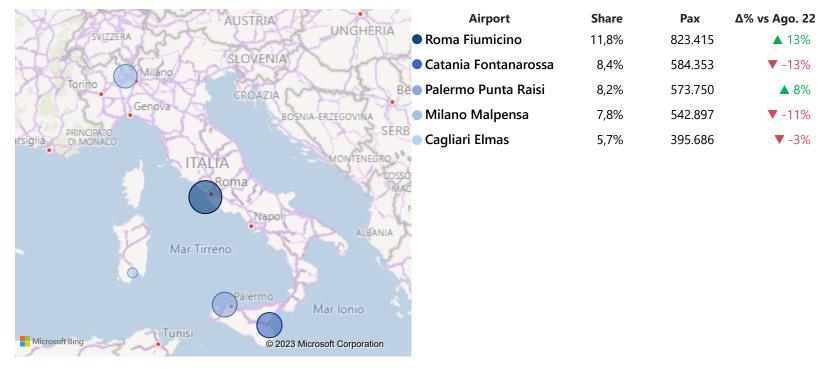
Traffic data related to **passengers** show as during **August 2023** about **21,3 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+11,7%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+4,1%** compared to August 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **August 2023** air traffic reached about **77,9 K tons**, recording a **decrease** of **-1,4%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+6,4%** compared to August 2019.



Passengers - August 2023 National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In August the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 6.957.078 units, corresponding to **33%** out of the total and steady values with a variation of -,3% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **2.920.101 units**, accounting for the **42%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with una flessione del **-1,2%** compared to August. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 12%, which matches to 823.415 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Palermo Punta Raisi represent the main route.

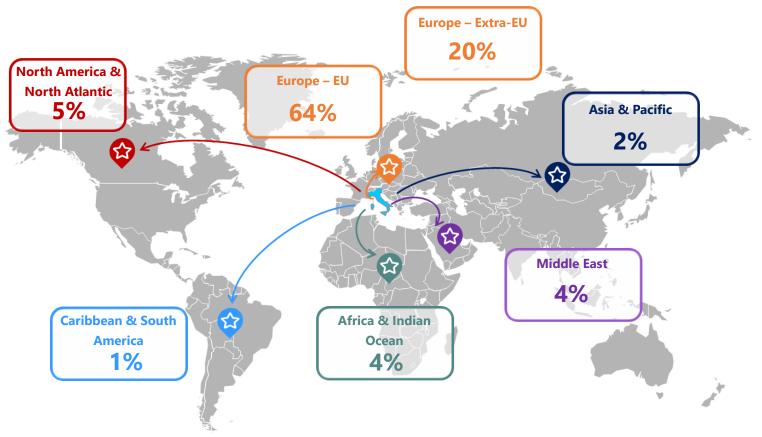




Passengers - August 2023

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In August the **international passengers** traffic recorded **14.335.351 units**, corresponding to **67%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+18,7%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (6.957.078 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.

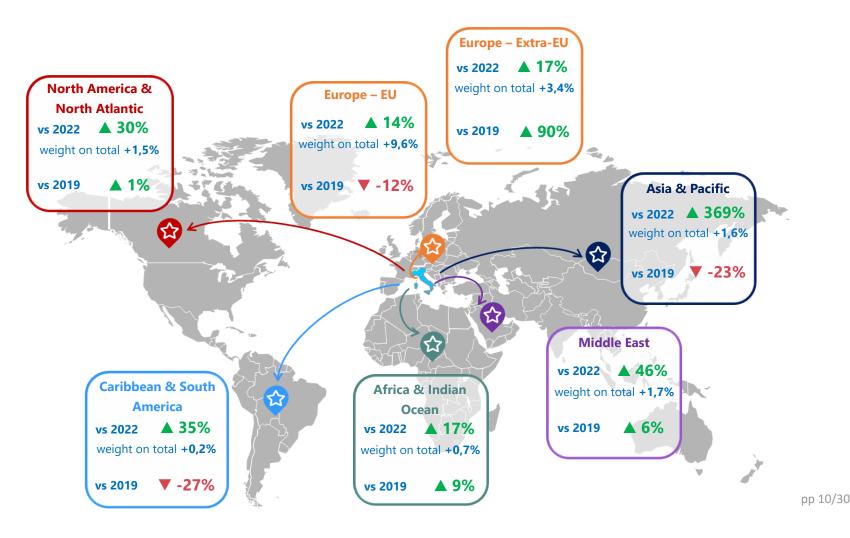


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Passengers - August 2023

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: +369,0%, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,6%, meaning +189.625 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +9,6%, meaning +1.159.390 passengers.

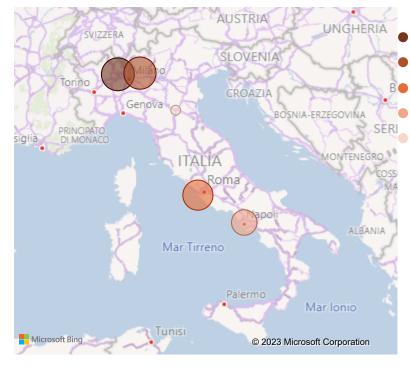




Passengers - August 2023

Low-cost Carriers

In August the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 11.771.503 units, corresponding to **55%** out of the total and a decrease of **-6,6%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 11 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **5.782.686 units**, accounting for the **49%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with a decrease of -3,4% compared to August. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 12%, which matches to 1.419.403 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

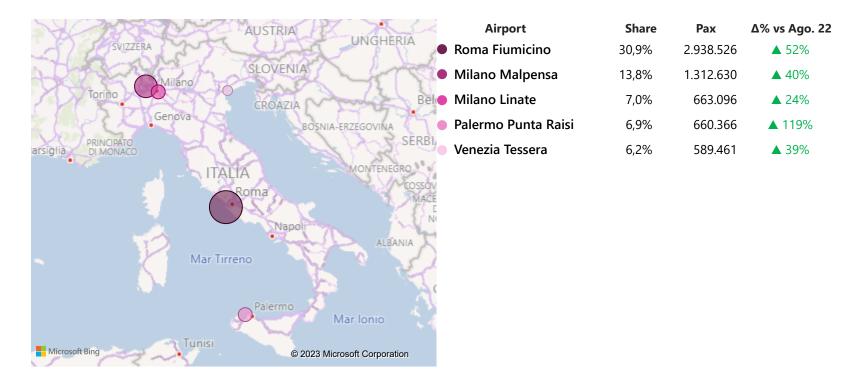

Legacy Carriers

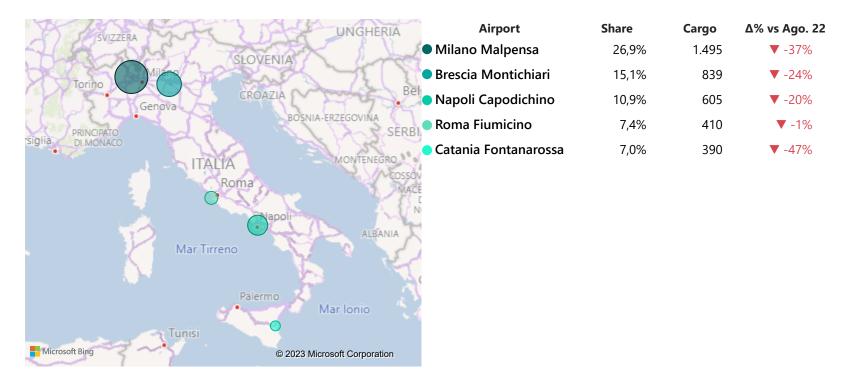
In August the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 9.520.926 units, corresponding to **45%** out of the total and an increase of **+48,3%** compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 11 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **6.164.079 units**, accounting for the **65%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +49,0% compared to August 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 31%, which matches to 2.938.526 passengers. Connections Palermo Punta Raisi - Roma Fiumicino represent the main route.





Cargo - August 2023 National Scope - Top-5 Airports

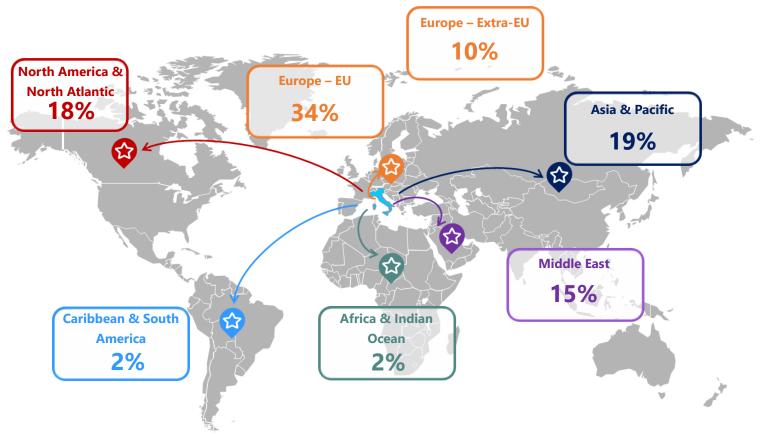
In August the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 5.554 tons, corresponding to **7%** out of total and a decrease of -27,7% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.739 tons**, accounting for the **67%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-32,0%** compared to August 2022. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 27%, which matches to 1.495 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.



Cargo - August 2023

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In August the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **72.312 tons**, corresponding to **93%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+1,4%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (5.554 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.



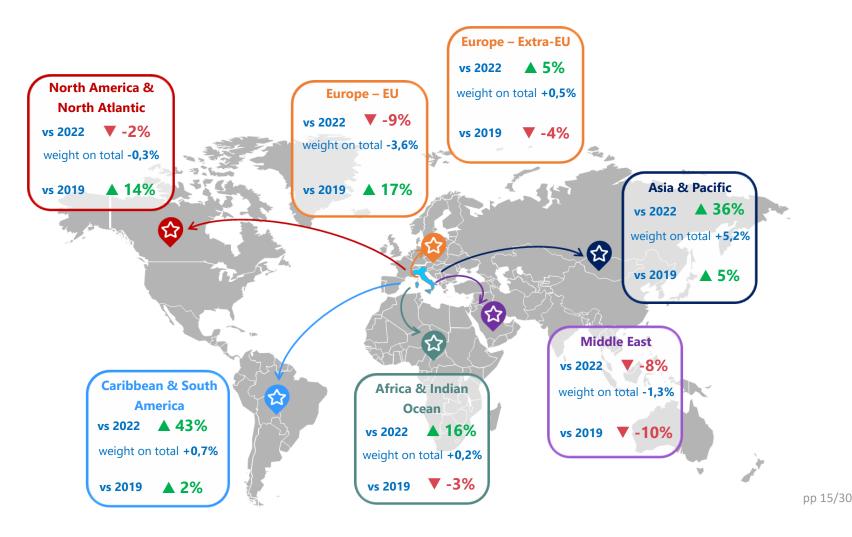
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Cargo - August 2023

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International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: **+42,7%** area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,7%, meaning **+528** tons. In **relative** terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: **+5,2%**, meaning **+3.691** tons.

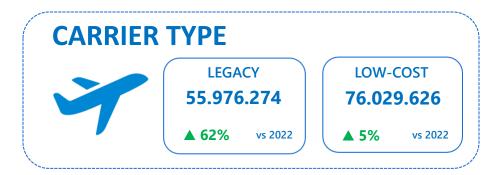


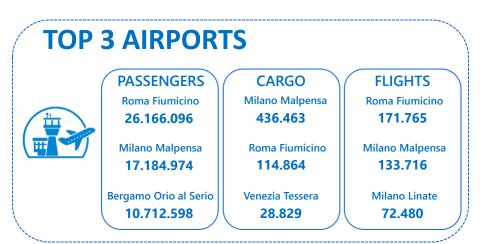




Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.





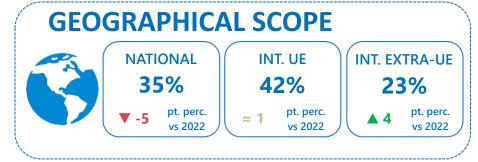


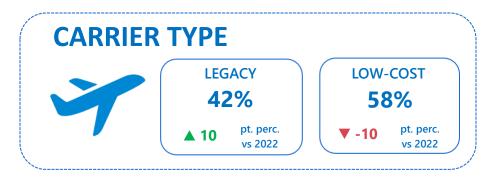


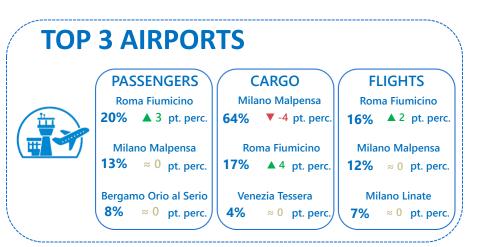


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Passenger share by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - August have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2022) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

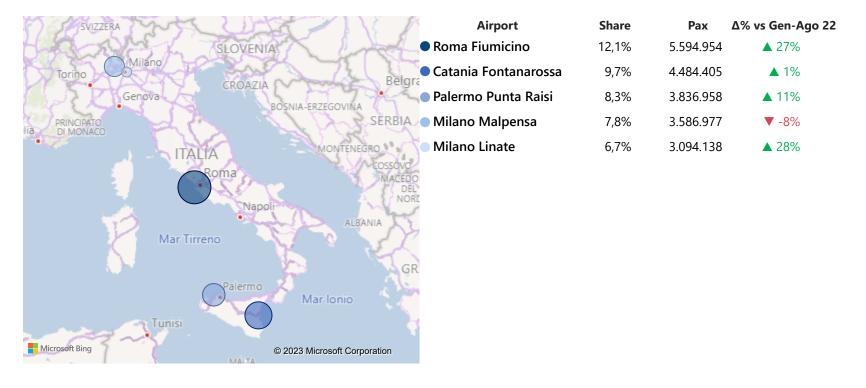
Traffic data related to **passengers** show as during the period **January - August** about **132,0 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+23,4%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+1,3%** compared to the period January - August 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - August** air traffic reached about **683,6 K tons**, recording a **decrease** of **-4,1%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has not recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a negative trend of **-0,6%** compared to January - August 2019.



Passengers – January - August 2023 National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - August, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 46.229.948 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of +8,3% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **20.597.432 units**, accounting for the **45%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+9,4%** compared to January - August 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 12%, witch matches to 5.594.954 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.

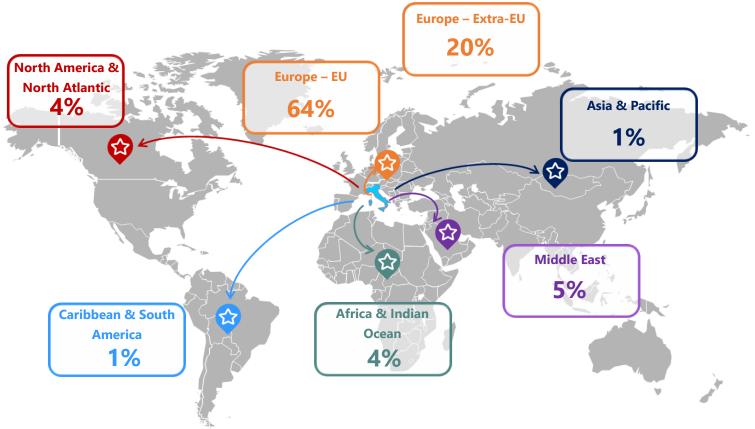




Passengers – January - August 2023

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - January - August the **international passengers** traffic recorded **85.775.952 units**, corresponding to **65%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+33,3%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (46.229.948 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.

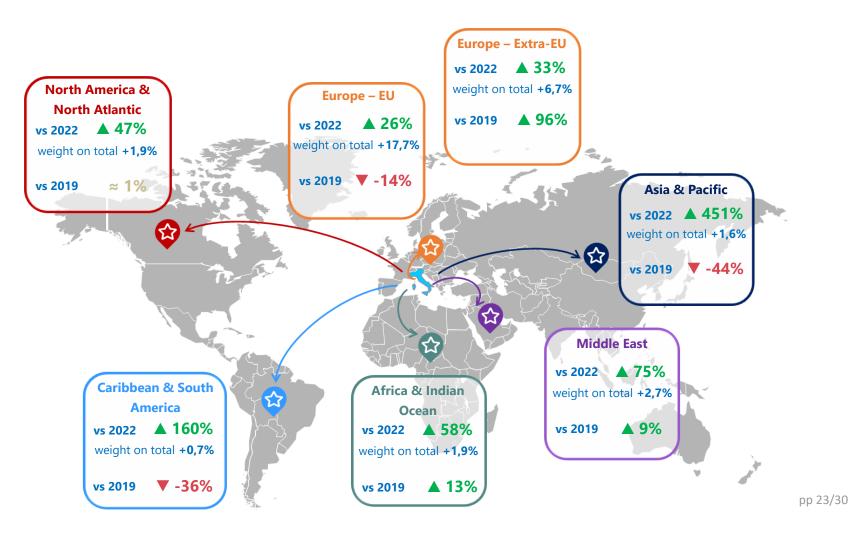




Passengers – January - August 2023

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific:** +451,2% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,6%, meaning +1.045.474 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +17,7%, meaning +11.393.672 passengers.





Passengers – January - August 2023 Low-cost Carriers

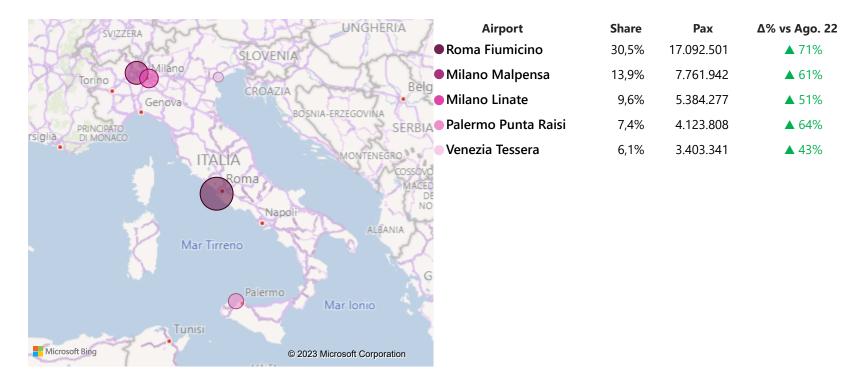
During the period January - August the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 76.029.626 units, corresponding to **58%** out of the total and an increase of **+5,0%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 10 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **39.581.901 units**, accounting for the **52%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +8,7% compared to January - August 2022. **Bergamo Orio al Serio** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 13%, which matches to 9.854.552 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

Passengers – January - August 2023 Legacy Carriers

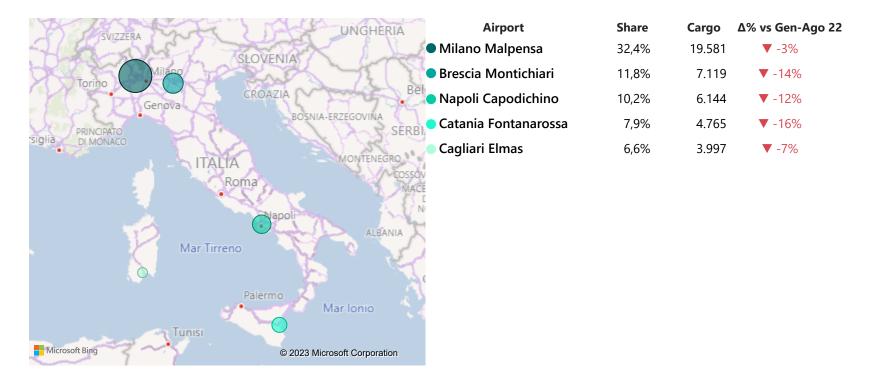
During the period January - August the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 55.976.274 units, corresponding to **42%** out of the total and an increase of **+61,8%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 10 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **37.765.869 units**, accounting for the **67%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +62,3% compared to January - August 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 31%, which matches to 17.092.501 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.





Cargo – January - August 2023 National Scope - Top-5 Airports

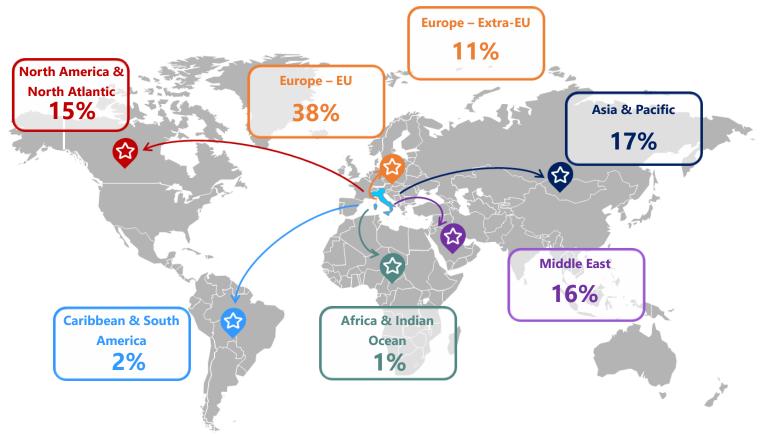
During the period January - August, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 60.344 tons, corresponding to **9%** out of the total and a decrease of -9,0% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **41.606 tons**, accounting for the **69%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-8,2%** compared to January - August 2022. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 32%, witch matches to 19.581 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.



Cargo – January - August 2023

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - August the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **623.292 tons**, corresponding to **91%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is a **decrease** of **-3,6%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (60.344 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Leipzig-Halle** the main route.





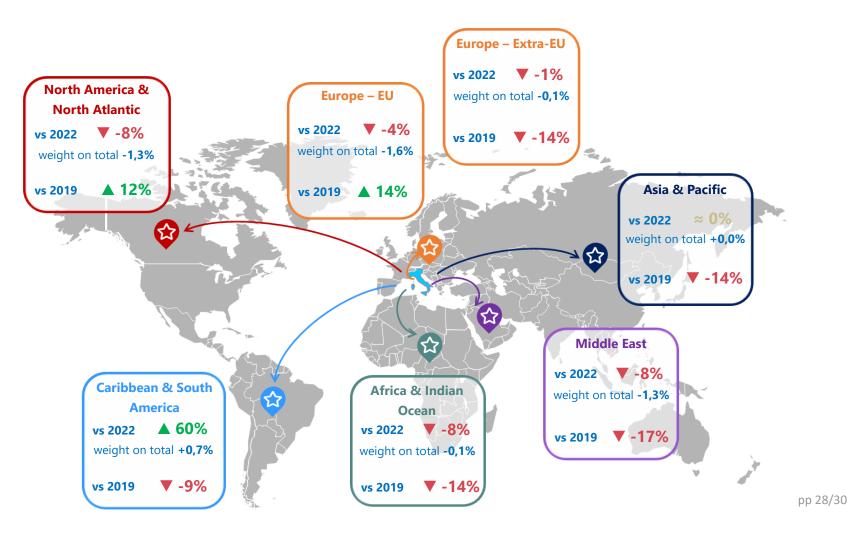
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Cargo – January - August 2023

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in **absolute** terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: **+59,6%** area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,7%, meaning **+4.777** tons. Also in **relative** terms, **Caribbean & South America** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: **+0,7%**.
