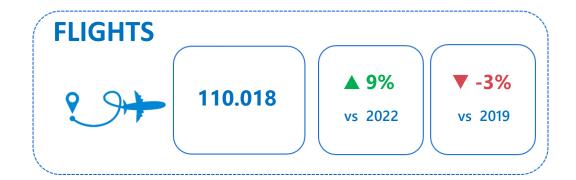

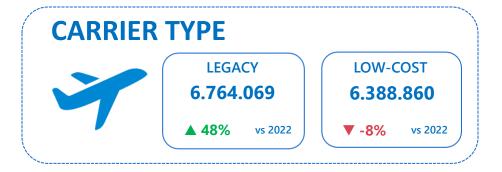

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.







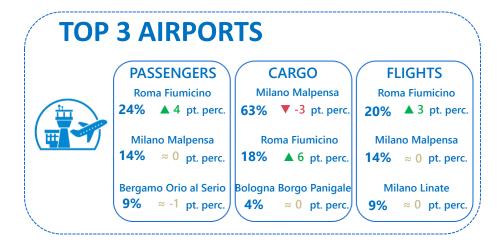

Key data - November 2023

Comparison to same period 2022 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to November 2023 have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2022) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during **November 2023** about **13,2 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+13,9%** compared to the same month of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passengers sector **has not recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a negative trend of **-0,4%** compared to November 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during **November 2023** air traffic reached about **95,1 K tons**, recording an **increase** del **+3,1%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Assuming as benchmark 2019, cargo sector **has not recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a negative trend of **-1,2%** compared to November 2019.



National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In November the **national passengers** air traffic recorded 4.658.912 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of +4,7% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **2.379.422** units, accounting for the 51% out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of +10,9% compared to November. Roma Fiumicino is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 16%, which matches to 758.654 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.

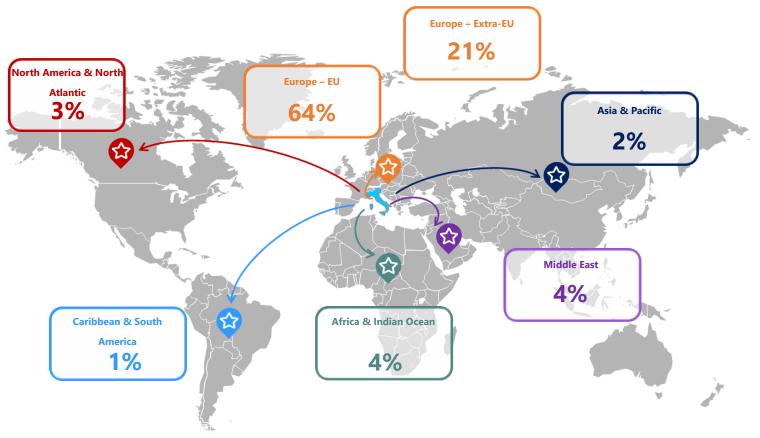

International Scope - Share by geographical area

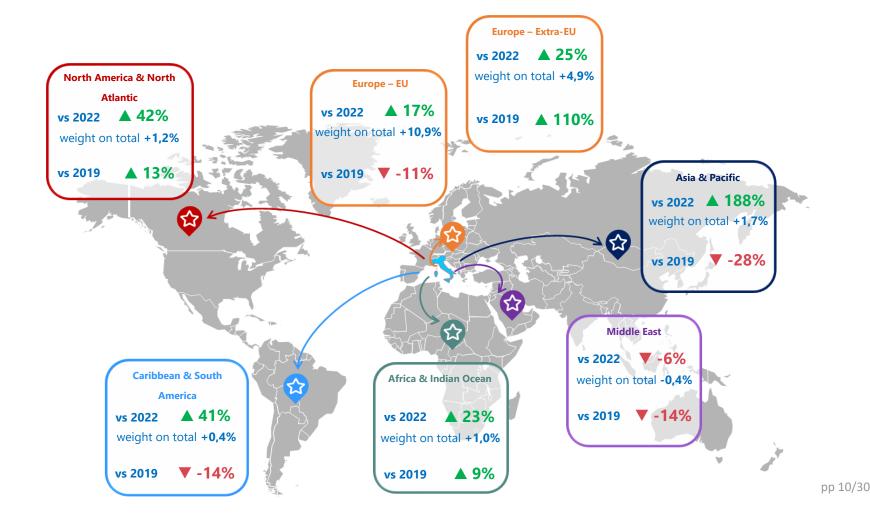
In November the **international passengers** traffic recorded **8.494.017 units**, corresponding to **65%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+19,7%**. Data have been processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (4.658.912 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.





International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific** area: **+188,3%**, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by **+1,7%**, meaning **+122.331** passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: **+10,9%**, meaning **+773.485** passengers.





Low-cost Carriers

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In November the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 6.388.860 units, corresponding to **49%** out of the total and a decrease of **-8,1%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 12 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **3.668.661 units**, accounting for the **57%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with a decrease of -5,6% compared to November. **Bergamo Orio al Serio** is the first airport in terms of low-cost air traffic, with a market share of 16%, which matches to 1.046.656 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.





Legacy Carriers

In November the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 6.764.069 units, corresponding to **51%** out of the total and an increase of **+47,6%** compared to the same month of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 12 percentage points. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.741.302 units**, accounting for the **70%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +43,4% compared to November 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 34%, which matches to 2.304.390 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

Cargo - November 2023

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

In November the **national cargo** air traffic recorded 7.480 tons, corresponding to **8%** out of total and a decrease of -18,6% compared to the same period of the previous year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **4.955 tons**, accounting for the 66% out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of -22,3% compared to November 2022. Milano Malpensa is the first airport in terms of national cargo air traffic, with a market share of 30%, which matches to 2.230 tons. Connections Milano Malpensa - Napoli Capodichino represent the main route.

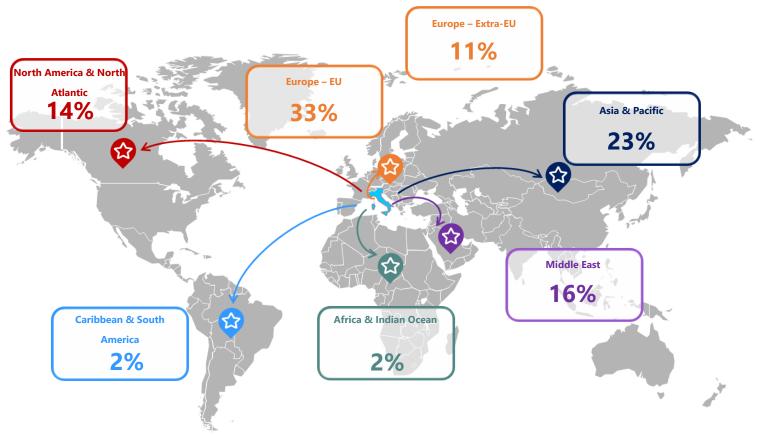

International Scope - Share by geographical area

In November the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **87.640 tons**, corresponding to **92%** out of total. As compared to the same month of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+5,5%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (7.480 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Doha Hamad Intl** the main route.



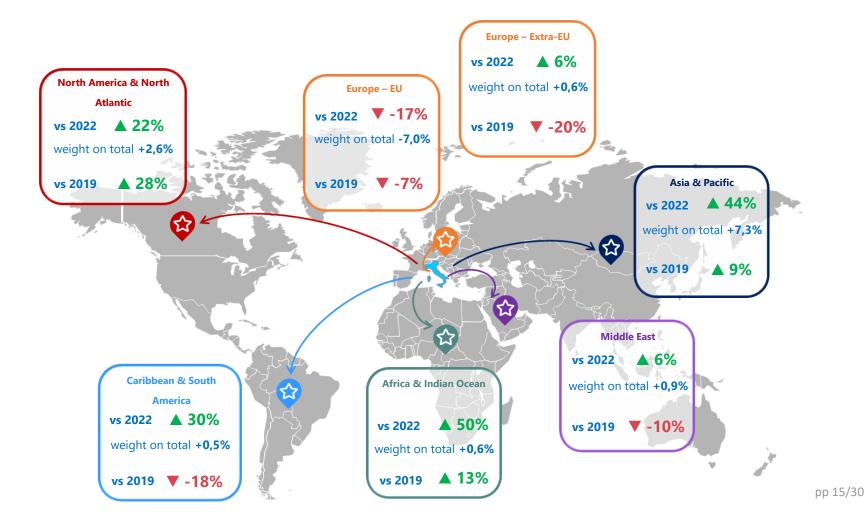
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Cargo - November 2023

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Africa & Indian Ocean**: **+49,8%** area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,6%, meaning **+517** tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Asia & Pacific** has been the geographic area that had the greates impact on total traffic: **+7,3%**, meaning **+6.086** tons.

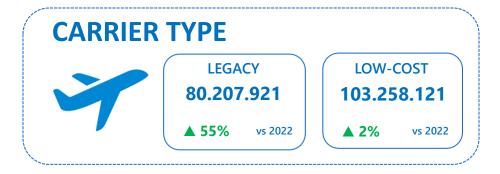

Passenger traffic by geographic scope and carrier type. Rank top-3 apt.



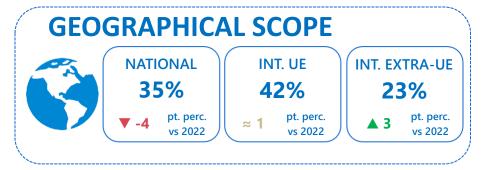




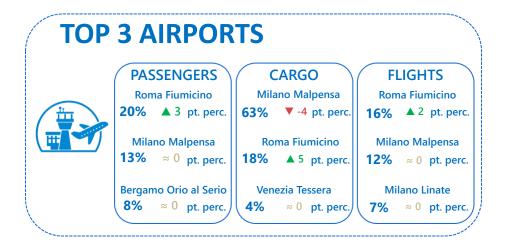

Comparison to same period 2022 and 2019

The nationwide air traffic data related to the period January - November have been compared to the same month of the previous year (2022) and to 2019, as pre-Pandemic benchmark. Here following the **scheduled** and **charter** traffic data related to passengers, cargo and flights.

Traffic data related to <u>passengers</u> show as during the period **January - November** about **183,5 M** of persons have been moved, recording an **increase** of **+20,2%** compared to the same period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, it results that the passenger sector **has recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a positive trend of **+2,3%** compared to the period January - November 2019.

As far as <u>cargo</u> sector concerns, during the period **January - November** air traffic reached about **968,9 K tons**, recording a **decrease** of **-2,1%** compared to the previous period of last year. Assuming 2019 as benchmark, cargo sector **has not recovered pre-Pandemic values**, with a negative trend of **-0,2%** compared to January - November 2019.



Passengers – January - November 2023

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - November, **domestic passengers** air traffic recorded 63.708.158 units, corresponding to **35%** out of the total and an increase of +6,6% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **28.764.354 units**, accounting for the **45%** out of total domestic passengers traffic, with an increase of **+8,4%** compared to January - November 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 13%, witch matches to 7.992.841 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Catania Fontanarossa represent the main route.

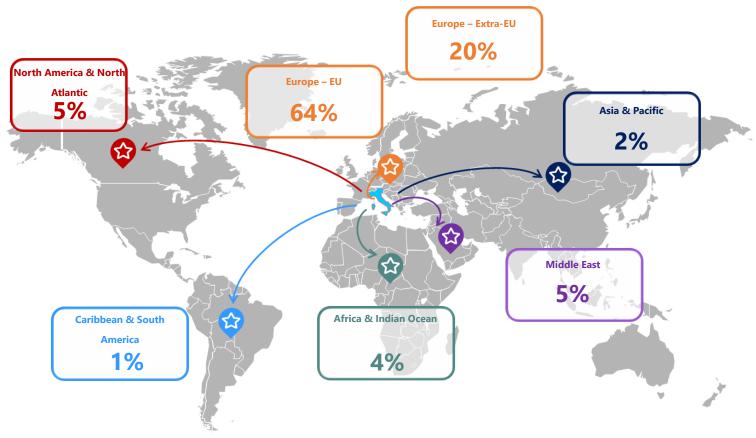




Passengers – January - November 2023

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - January - November the **international passengers** traffic recorded **119.757.884 units**, corresponding to **65%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is an **increase** of **+29,0%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (63.708.158 passengers). The **Europe - EU**, is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed with **Spain** being the first country and **Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas** the main route.

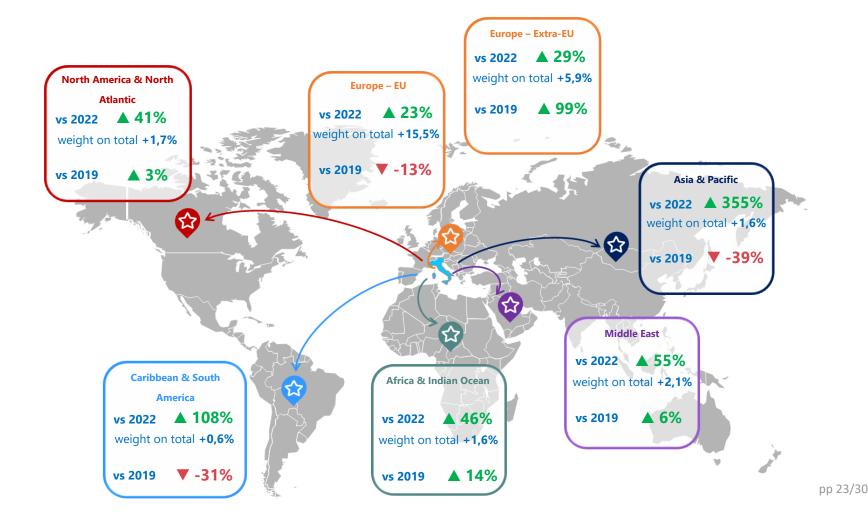

International Scope - Change in traffic by geographical area

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Asia & Pacific**: +355,3% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +1,6%, meaning +1.492.147 passengers. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, the **Europe - EU** has been the geographic area that had the gratest impact on total traffic: +15,5%, meaning +14.415.857 passengers.





Passengers – January - November 2023

Low-cost Carriers

During the period January - November the **low-cost** passengers air traffic recorded 103.258.121 units, corresponding to **56%** out of the total and an increase of **+2,2%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparision between low-cost and legacy segments shows that the **share** of low-cost has decreased by 10 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **53.972.458 units**, accounting for the **52%** out of total low-cost passengers traffic, with an increase of +5,1% compared to January - November 2022. **Bergamo Orio al Serio** is the first airport in terms of national air traffic, with a market share of 13%, which matches to 13.404.377 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Barcelona El Prat represent the main route.

Passengers – January - November 2023

Legacy Carriers

During the period January - November the **legacy** passengers air traffic recorded 80.207.921 units, corresponding to **44%** out of the total and an increase of **+55,5%** compared to the same period of the previous year. Furthermore, the comparison between legacy and low-cost segments shows that the share of legacy has increased by 10 percentage points . **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **54.161.525 units**, accounting for the **68%** out of total legacy passengers traffic, with an increase of +54,4% compared to January - November 2022. **Roma Fiumicino** is the first airport in terms of legacy air traffic, with a market share of 31%, which matches to 24.918.656 passengers. Connections Roma Fiumicino - Madrid Barajas represent the main route.

Cargo – January - November 2023

National Scope - Top-5 Airports

During the period January - November, **domestic cargo** air traffic recorded 81.455 tons, corresponding to **8%** out of the total and a decrease of -12,4% compared to the same period of last year. **Top five airports** reached a traffic of **55.381 tons**, accounting for the **68%** out of total domestic cargo traffic, with a decrease of **-13,4%** compared to January - November 2022. **Milano Malpensa** is the first airport in terms of domestic air traffic, with a market share of 32%, witch matches to 25.862 tons. Connections Napoli Capodichino - Milano Malpensa represent the main route.

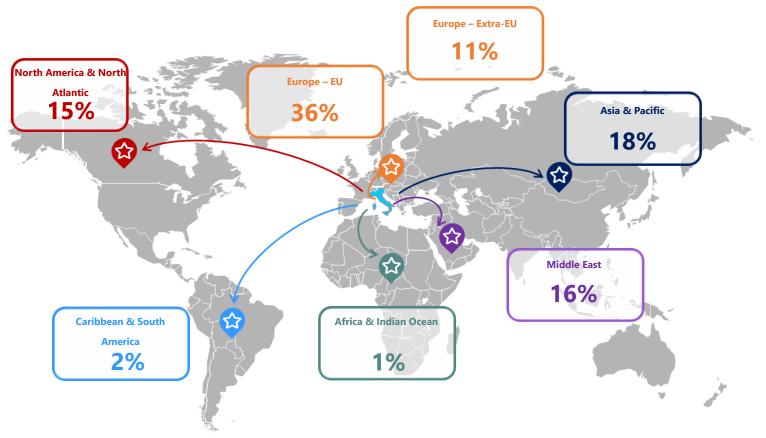




Cargo – January - November 2023

International Scope - Share by geographical area

During the period January - November the **international cargo** air traffic recorded **887.448 tons**, corresponding to **92%** out of total. As compared to the same period of the previous year, there is **steady values**, with a variation of **-1,0%**. Data are processed excluding national traffic, therefore the traffic share with European Union does not include domestic one (81.455 tons). The **Europe - EU** is the geographical area to which the most traffic is observed, with **Germany** being the first country and **Milano Malpensa - Leipzig-Halle** the main route.

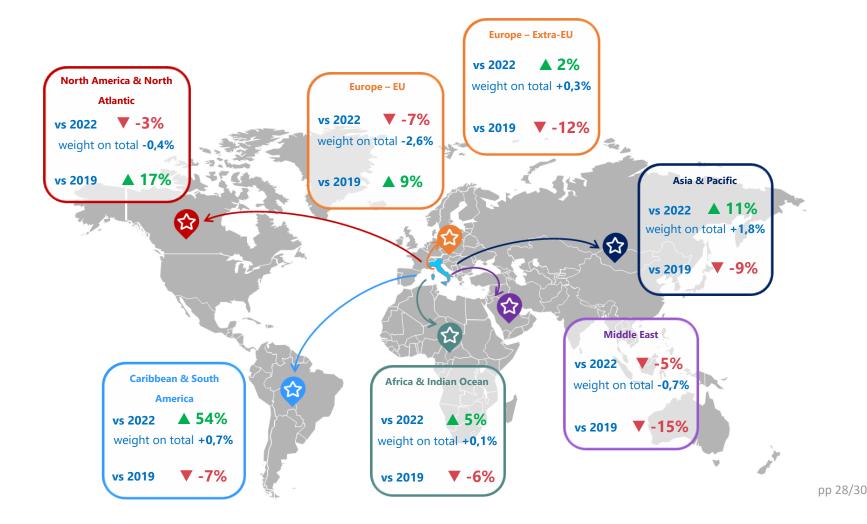




Cargo – January - November 2023

Data elaborated by geographical area show how, in <u>absolute</u> terms, the highest growth rate has been recorded in **Caribbean & South America**: +54,2% area, corresponding to an increase of total international traffic by +0,7%, meaning +6.621 tons. In <u>relative</u> terms, instead, **Asia & Pacific** as been the geographic area that had the greatest impact on total traffic: +1,8%, meaning +15.769 tons.
